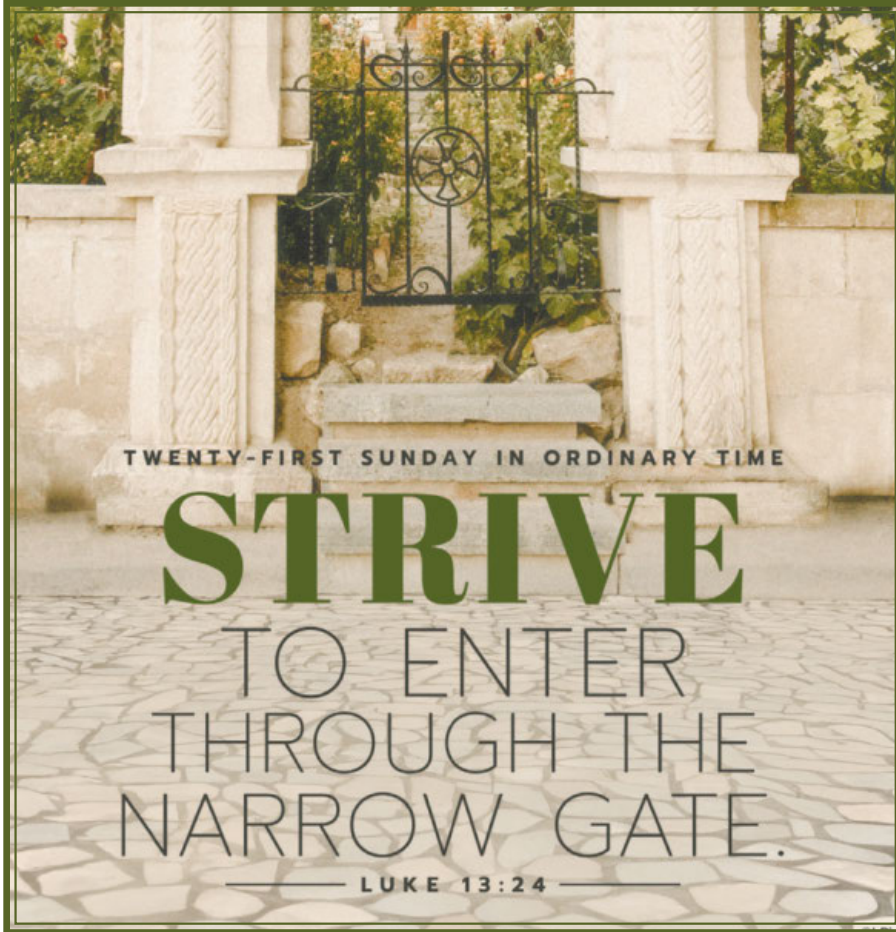




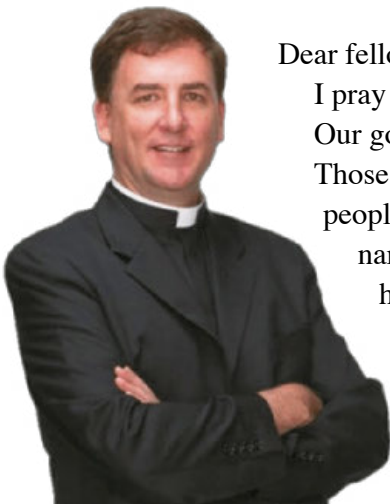

RESPOND WITH COMPASSION

In light of the ongoing humanitarian crisis in Gaza and surrounding areas, we are being called to respond with compassion and urgency. Our Church grieves the immense suffering of Christians and other innocent victims enduring violence, displacement and dire living conditions.

SNCS AUCTION: SAVE THE DATE

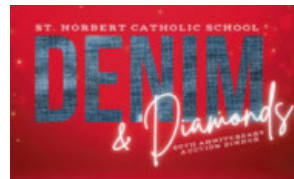

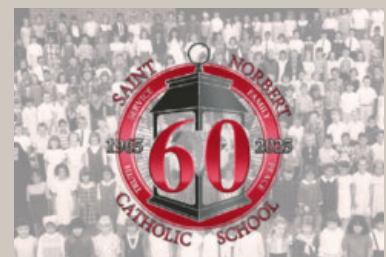

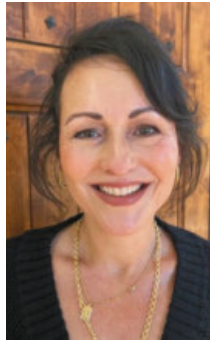
