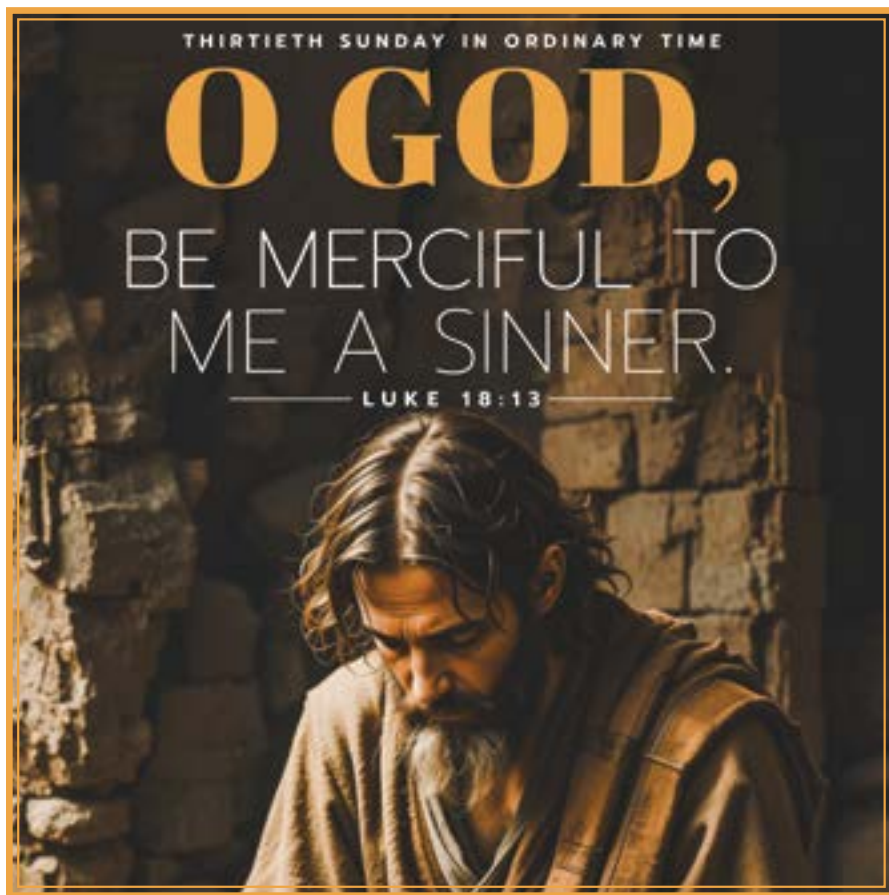

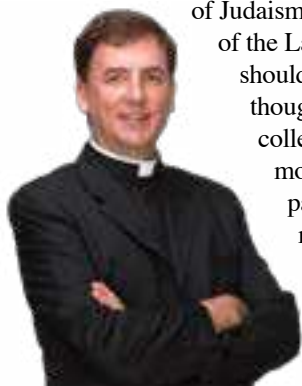
Pastor's Message

Dear fellow parishioners,

On this 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus talks about how we should feel when we pray. He compares the prayer of a Pharisee to the prayer of a tax collector, and he wants His disciples to learn to pray with humility before God. Jesus again surprises everyone by showing the tax collector as the one who truly believes, not the Pharisee. The Pharisees were members of a sect

of Judaism active in Jesus' time that taught an oral interpretation of the Law of Moses as the basis for Jewish piety. If anyone should know how to pray, it would be a Pharisee. Jesus, though, offers the tax collector as a model for prayer. Tax collectors worked with the Roman authorities and charged more than the defined taxes and made a profit. In this parable, Jesus offers the humility of the tax collector as a model for the prayer of a disciple. The parable reminds us that when we pray, we must remember our need for God in our lives. If we are too full of ourselves, there is too little room for God's grace to work in us.

A special altar decorated with marigolds and pictures, personal objects and favorite foods of the departed is created to mark a sacred space. We invite the St. Norbert community to participate in

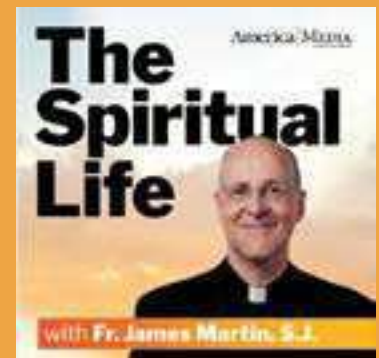
SHARE YOUR GIFT OF MUSIC, JOIN THE CHOIR

Mis queridos feligreses,
En este 30° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, Jesús habla sobre cómo debemos sentirnos al orar. Compara la oración de un fariseo con la de un recaudador de impuestos, y quiere que sus discípulos aprendan a orar con humildad ante Dios. Jesús sorprende de nuevo al mostrar al recaudador de impuestos como el que verdaderamente cree, no al fariseo. Los fariseos eran miembros de una secta del judaísmo activa en tiempos de Jesús que enseñaba una interpretación oral de la Ley de Moisés como base de la piedad judía. Si alguien sabía orar, ese era un fariseo. Sin embargo, Jesús presenta al

recaudador de impuestos como modelo de oración. Los recaudadores de impuestos trabajaban con las autoridades romanas, cobraban más de los impuestos establecidos y obtenían ganancias. En esta parábola, Jesús presenta la humildad del recaudador de impuestos como modelo para la oración de un discípulo. La parábola nos recuerda que, al orar, debemos tener presente nuestra necesidad de Dios en nuestras vidas. Si nos enorgullecemos demasiado, hay muy poco espacio para que la gracia de Dios obre en nosotros.

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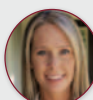


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
