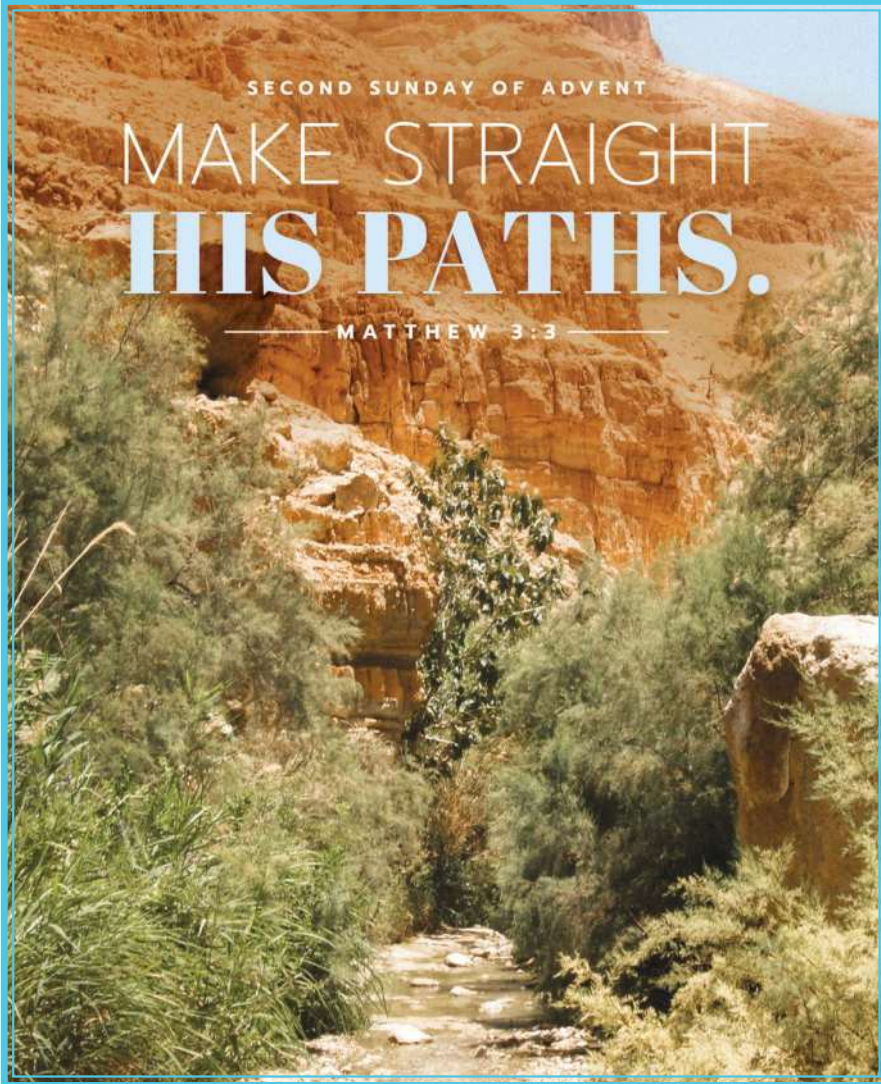

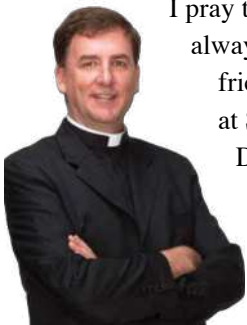

CHRISTIAN SERVICE: FOOD DISTRIBUTION UPDATES

The weekend before Thanksgiving, we served a record number of 527 families, which fed over 2,000 people! We are so thankful for our St. Norbert Church community, which includes the school, parish, Family & Life Formation classes, Confirmation program and Youth Ministry, for all the donations of food items for Thanksgiving.



As we prepare our budget for 2026, we are currently spending \$5.99 per family per week. The weekly purchases include two canned food items, rice, beans, pasta and fresh produce. Typically, we serve around 430 families from over 25 different cities.

NEWS UPDATE

THANKSGIVING PIES DONATED TO COMMUNITY CAUSES

This year we continued our parish's long-standing tradition started by Larry and Jeanne Honikel of donating holiday pies to organizations that help homeless and low-income residents in the community.

For Thanksgiving, we had 142 store-bought and homemade pies donated. They were delivered to Southwest Community Center, Isaiah House and St. Francis Home in Santa Ana.

In Orange, pies went to The Hub, Casa Teresa, House of Hope and the Ronald McDonald House and also to 20 people in the Meals on Wheels program.

El fin de semana previo al Día de Acción de Gracias, atendimos a un número récord de 527 familias, ¡que alimentaron a más de 2,000 personas! Estamos muy agradecidos con nuestra comunidad de la Iglesia de San Norberto, que incluye la escuela, la parroquia, las clases de Formación en la Fe, el programa de Confirmación y el Ministerio Juvenil, por todas las donaciones de alimentos para el Día de Acción de Gracias.

Mientras preparamos nuestro presupuesto para el 2026, actualmente gastamos \$5.99 por familia a la semana. Las compras semanales incluyen dos alimentos enlatados, arroz, frijoles, pasta y productos frescos. Normalmente, atendemos a unas 430 familias de más de 25 ciudades.

RECONCILIACIÓN DURANTE EL ADVIENTO

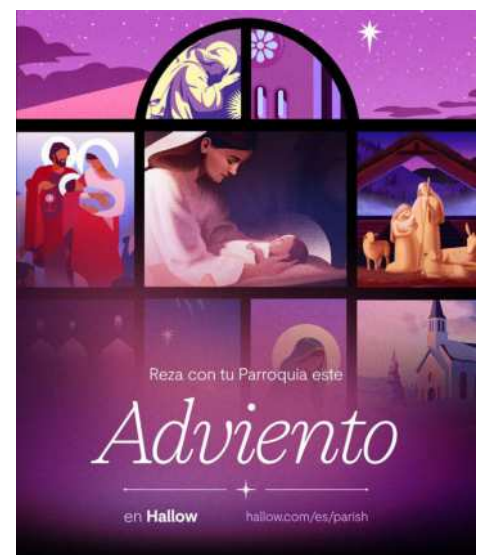

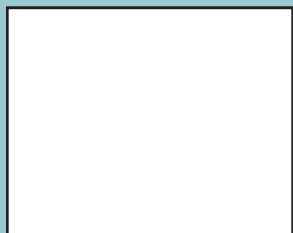
