Some families ask about eulogies. Here at St. Therese, it is preferred that eulogies be given at the funeral home or at the luncheon. During this time of COVID-19 many families are opting out of such gatherings. A eulogy is NOT required, nor is it encouraged. Instead, families should share stories of their loved one at family gatherings throughout the year. However, if a eulogy would like to be given at the time of the Funeral Mass, here are the guidelines:

- 1. Only one person should deliver the eulogy.
- 2. The eulogy should be written out to assist the one who is to deliver it.
- 3. The eulogy should be no more than 5 minutes long.
- 4. The eulogy is delivered prior to the start of Mass (i.e., 9:55 AM for a 10 AM liturgy).
- 5. Because we are in a sacred space, the eulogy must not contain vulgarities, off-color jokes, political commentary, or anything which would be offensive to the Catholic faith or persons who are in attendance.
