

Summer 2026 Math Work Rising Grades 6-8

Happy Summer incoming St. Augustine Rising Middle Schoolers! You worked hard throughout this last year. Along the way you have learned new skills and strengthened previous ones. Mastery of these basic skills is essential to your success next year and beyond. Summer practice will be important to do just this! This summer you will be using IXL recommendations as determined by your end of the year IXL assessment.

Students must sign into their IXL account. Once they are in, they should be brought right to the "MY IXL" tab. On the right-hand side, they should see a box with a picture of an arena and "keep your levels up to date" underneath. They then need to click on "see your action plan". Once this opens, it'll show exactly what skills under which standard they need to complete. They simply click on a skill and get to work. Use the provided lessons to help learn. Copy at least three problems and keep a paper work sheet for each topic. Staple and hand in the packet by Aug 26. It is expected that all students complete at least 2 new skills per week for 8 weeks over the course of the summer. Students should work until they achieve at least an 80% on each skill before moving on to the next one. This will be worth your first quiz grade of the new year. Ms. Boutcher will be monitoring their usage over the summer and check their completion at the start of the school year.
