DEAR HOLY EASTER PEOPLE OF GOD:

A story for all - a couple, whose son had been injured badly in a car accident, said:

"We visit our son every week because it is our duty as parents, but we stopped loving him. We know very well that love is giving and receiving, and our son cannot receive and give love anymore. One day, when we went to visit him, we were surprised that he already had a visitor in his room. We did not know this person. He was a stranger.

"Later on, we have known that the visitor is a Eucharistic Minister from the parish. We saw him talking to our son, as if our son could understand every word that's being said. The man took out a Bible and read a prayer as if our son could appreciate a prayer. Then he gave him communion as if our son could be conscious of the bread he received. But it dawned in us that the man does know and see our son not simply as a dying man but a man of faith. He treated our son as God's child!"

The Eucharistic Minister was a stranger to the young man, yet he was instrumental on sharing God's presence and love to him. In his dying moments, the son rediscovered God's love and reenergized his fading faith to picture in his memory the Risen Christ on the cross, who said: **"Today, you will be with me in paradise!"**

Like the parents in our story and the disciples in our gospel, we easily forget Jesus in our life. Sometimes we don't recognize him when he speaks to us through people who love, encourage and help us. We don't recognize his voice when he cries out to us in the poor, the sick, the hungry and abandoned. Like the disciples, when we are so desperate, empty, and ready to give up, God's love touches our barren hearts, and we pray: **"Stay with us Lord!"**

Today, the Risen Christ comes into our midst, not as a stranger, but in the form of bread and wine. It is not us anymore who tells him, **"Stay with us, Lord"** but it is him who invites us, **"Stay with me. This is my Body, this is my Blood - for you."** Jesus is renewing his covenant with us. He wants to breathe **"love"** in us, so that all we say, think and do is completely inspired by God. A **Eucharistic love** that will lead us to our mission: to heal rather than harm; to forgive rather than hate; to be humble rather than to be hypocrite; to be peacemaker rather than a trouble maker; and to be welcoming rather than rejecting others.

For personal reflection: **"When your journey seems dark, where do you turn to find your way back to the light? Is it to the Risen Christ or someone else?"**

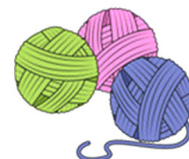

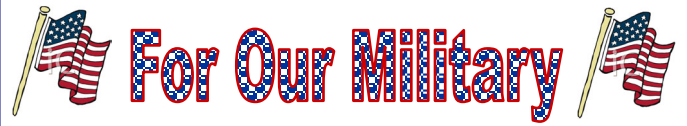

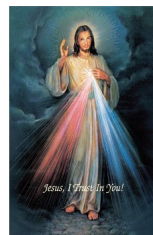

OUR PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

We, the people of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Faith Community, Baptized into Jesus Christ, formed by Word and Sacrament, and Empowered by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, Seek to be a visible sign of God's love. TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Some monks and nuns trace their community origins back a thousand years or so, before it became customary to reserve the Blessed Sacrament in tabernacles. In their rules of life, which evolved from the lifestyle and prayer of their predecessors, the core experience of Christ's presence is at the altar itself, and in the symbol of assembly for prayer. To this day, when the monks or nuns file into their church in procession, they march two by two, and then bow profoundly to the altar before turning and bowing in reverence toward the brother or sister at their side. It is probably more difficult, in practice, to revere the presence of Christ in a person who irks you by taking the car keys, shirking a work duty, or burning the toast!

We can trace in these religious orders' enduring customs the ancient appreciation for the altar as the center of the church building, and of the community of the faithful as the Body of Christ. Usually, a monastery today will reserve the Blessed Sacrament in some quiet corner of the monastic church, in a fairly small space, more suitable for private prayer than for the gathering of the whole community. In a cloister, the architecture may allow the public limited access to this space. Liturgical law tells us, in both monasteries and parish churches, that there is no need for more than a few hosts in the place of reservation, just enough for viaticum, the "food for the journey" that is the final sacramental celebration for a dying Christian.

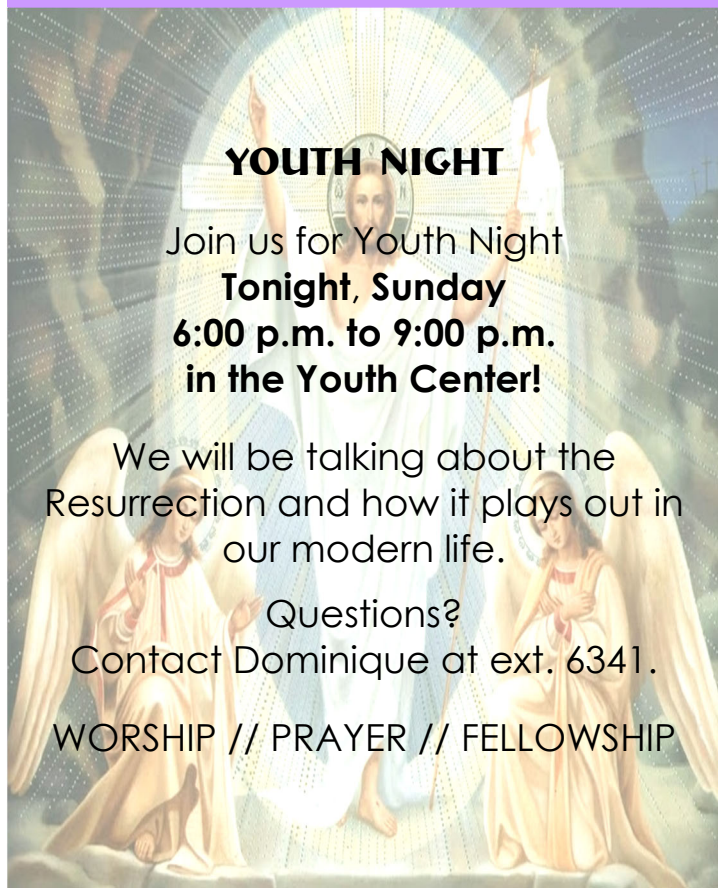

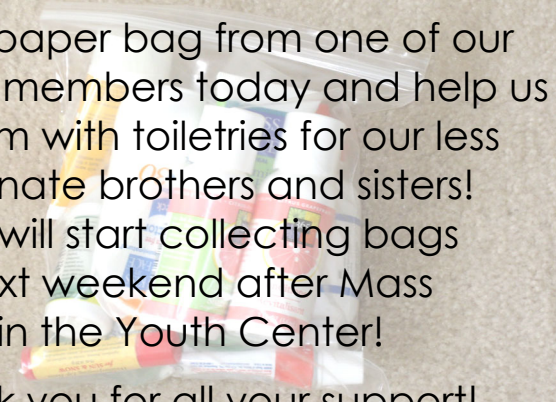
