DEAR HOLY EASTER PEOPLE OF GOD:

Today we are celebrating ASCENSION SUNDAY! Many are wondering why **Ascension Thursday** was transferred to **Ascension Sunday**. The following is the explanation from the Office of Worship of our Diocese:

"In 1993, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments in Rome issued an indult allowing the Dioceses in the Western United States to transfer the celebration of the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord to the Seventh Sunday of Easter. Since 1999, when the indult became permanent, with the exception of the ecclesiastical Provinces of Boston, Hartford, New York, Newark, Philadelphia, and the State of Nebraska who have retained its celebration on the proper of **Thursday**, all dioceses in the United States have opted to move the celebration to the **Seventh Sunday of Easter**. Therefore, the Solemnity of the **Ascension of the Lord** will always be celebrated in the Diocese of San Bernardino on **Sunday**."

Ascension is not the disappearance of Jesus but the graced moment when his mission is passed on into our lives, he said: **"Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit!"**

Jesus will vanish again from our sight but he becomes known in our words and actions as he missions us **"to love as he loved, to speak as he spoke, to offer our lives as he offered his, to do what he did: building networks of relationships founded on love; creating sanctuaries of hope; and healing the body of humanity that is still broken"**.

Ascension challenges us to work double time to put God back in the center of our lives. But we will not be alone; Jesus is with us, he promised: **"I am with you always, until the end of the age!"** However, in order to perpetuate his presence amongst us, he needs our collaboration by doing the following:

We become Jesus' hands as an expression of hospitality to the strangers in our midst, and let them experience God's love. We become Jesus' feet as instruments in carrying others' burdens to let them know that God cares. We become Jesus' eyes to shed tears with others when they are alone and lonely to show that God is compassionate. We become Jesus' words as we speak words of mercy, love, forgiveness and hope to our neighbors.

Then, people will tell you: "How come when I see you, I see the Christ in you!" And you will answer, "Because it is the Christ in you that recognizes the Christ in me."

Today, at this very minute, let the witnessing begin...

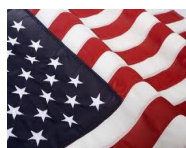

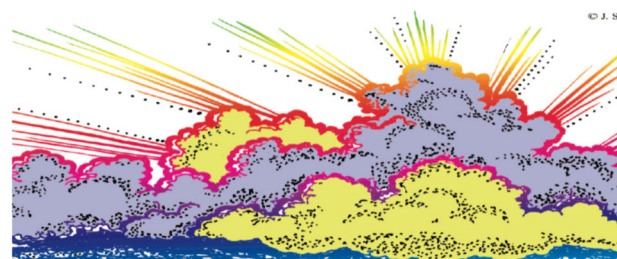

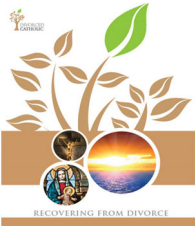

NOVENA TO THE HOLY SPIRIT



The Novena to the Holy Spirit is the first Novena of the Church prayed by the apostles and followers at the request of Our Lord, Jesus. He told the apostles to go to Jerusalem and wait for the Paraclete, the Holy Spirit.

Jesus said in *Matthew 7:7* "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened." With this confidence we ask for the gifts of the Holy Spirit through these Novenas.

As a community, we will pray the Novena to the Holy Spirit from **May 27th through June 4th**
15 minutes before each Mass:

Saturday, May 27th and June 3th
5:00 p.m., 7:00 p.m. (Spanish Mass)

Sunday, May 28th and June 4th
11:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Weekday May 29th, 30th, 31th, June 1st and 2nd
8:00 a.m.

On **Saturday, June 3rd, Sunday, June 4th and Monday, June 5th** Masses, the Gifts and Fruits of the Holy Spirit will be given out.
(1 Corinthians 12)

For private recitation, or prayer at home with your family, recite the follow prayer beginning **May 27th until June 4th**, the Feast of the Holy Spirit. This Novena is prayed before Pentecost, but can be prayed anytime during the year.
