DEAR HOLY EASTER PEOPLE OF GOD:

Today is PENTECOST SUNDAY! The gospel says: **"Peace be with you... Receive the Holy Spirit..."**

And as a people filled with the Holy Spirit, let us celebrate this day as a NEW PENTECOST of COVENANT:

A NEW COVENANT OF PEACE that challenges every person of goodwill to become genuine and courageous peacemakers in this world of violence, war and scandals. The Holy Spirit becomes our **life-energy** who will make our hearts burning with harmony and peace.

A NEW COVENANT OF FORGIVENESS that offers healing and conversion that will constantly change our hearts of stone into hearts of flesh. The Holy Spirit becomes our **life-healer** who makes our hearts burning with mercy and transformation.

A NEW COVENANT OF CHRISTIAN SERVICE that boldly challenges us to become disciples who constantly serve each other without counting the cost, and if necessary, even willing to lay down one's life for one's friends. The Holy Spirit becomes our **life-sustainer** that affirms, inspires and renews us.

If we don't allow the Holy Spirit to make his dwelling in our hearts today, the picture of our world will be like this:

"When the world becomes Godless: nations become hopeless; governments become pathetic; politicians become remorseless; Christians become cynical; Churches become unholy places; morals become worthless and crimes become limitless."

But hope still glows in the dark, and life still summons us to a better tomorrow. This is because Jesus breathed into us the Holy Spirit: **"Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them..."** And the Holy Spirit makes holy people out of ordinary ones, and produces saints out of sinners.

Today, Pentecost Sunday - as the Holy Spirit makes his dwelling in your hearts, have faith that he transforms you as holy persons and consecrates you as living saints despite of your sins. So, beloved friends, beginning from this Eucharistic table: act as holy people, and live as saints.

For personal reflection and group sharing: **"What actions have you done that made you a holy person? Are those actions guiding others to become saints?"**

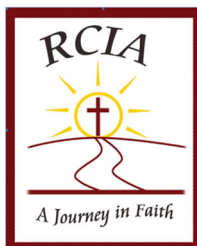

NOVENA TO THE HOLY SPIRIT



The Novena to the Holy Spirit is the first Novena of the Church prayed by the apostles and followers at the request of Our Lord, Jesus. He told the apostles to go to Jerusalem and wait for the Paraclete, the Holy Spirit.

Jesus said in *Matthew 7:7* "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened." With this confidence we ask for the gifts of the Holy Spirit through these Novenas.

As a community, we will pray the Novena to the Holy Spirit from **Now through June 4th**

15 minutes before each Mass:

Saturday, June 3th

5:00 p.m., 7:00 p.m. (*Spanish Mass*)

Sunday, June 4th

11:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

On Saturday, June 3rd, Sunday, June 4th and Monday, June 5th Masses, the Gifts and Fruits of the Holy Spirit will be given out.
(1 *Corinthians 12*)

For private recitation, or prayer at home with your family, recite the follow prayer beginning **Now until June 4th**, the Feast of the Holy Spirit. This Novena is prayed before Pentecost, but can be prayed anytime during the year.

PRAYER TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

Breathe into me, Holy Spirit, that my thoughts may all be holy. Move in me, Holy Spirit, that my work, too, may be holy. Attract my heart, Holy Spirit, that I may love only what is holy. Strengthen me, Holy Spirit that I may defend all that is holy. Protect me, Holy Spirit, that I may always be holy. St. Augustine

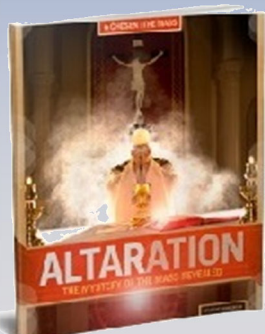

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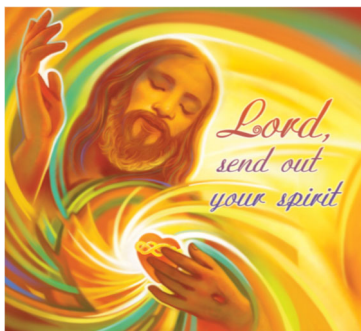
