DEAR HOLY PEOPLE OF GOD:

Today is the **FIRST SUNDAY of LENT!** It started on **ASH WEDNESDAY!** There is a Lenten image on **Ash Wednesday** that ushered in a vital reference to our spiritual renewal during the **SEASON of LENT.** It is the **CROSS** marked on our foreheads, and accompanied by these words: **“REPENT and BELIEVE in the GOSPEL!”**

The **CROSS** is very symbolic; it is not an amulet, but a sign that Jesus is always with us in our life. It is put on our foreheads so that it will become an icon that God is in our memory bank – and cannot be erased forever. Let us remember that the ritual is not magic, but a reminder that the **CROSS** is our salvation, our redemption and our liberation from sin! A **CROSS** that communicates to us the meaning of the word **ASH:**

A is not **ANGER** but **ANGELS!** Look at the **CROSS** – and let the love of Christ empty your heart from anger. With prayer fill your heart with love. And that love will teach you to be caring and compassionate to others. At the end, people will tell you, **“You are an ANGEL to me!”** How beautiful it is to hear those words from others! So, the **CROSS** is a producer of **ANGELS!**

S is not **SATAN** but **SAINTS!** Again, look at the **CROSS!** What you see is Jesus who invites you, a sinner, with these words, **“Today, you will be with me in paradise.”** He invites you to empty your minds with Satanic thoughts, and fill it with Holy works. As saints doing the corporal works of mercy, you will be walking with the **SAINTS** in heaven. And others will tell you, **“You look like the saints in heaven.”** So, the **CROSS** is a **SAINT** maker!

H is not **HATRED** but **HOLY!** Jesus is hanging and suffering at the **CROSS**, and for the third time, look at him again. Feeling so much pain, he tells you with love, **“Father, forgive them because they don’t know what they are doing.”** His merciful words are his healing and forgiving love. He is erasing all your sins, so that you become **HOLY.** So, the **CROSS** is a creator of **HOLY PEOPLE!**

So, today, when you come to receive the **BREAD of LIFE** and the **WINE of SALVATION**, believe that you can be an **Angel**, a **Saint** and **Holy.**

My only request to you is: **“TRUST GOD!”** Take your time to be an **ANGEL**, to be a **SAINT** and to be **HOLY** during this Season of **LENT!**
