DEAR HOLY PEOPLE OF GOD

PENTECOST SUNDAY! This is the moment of the indwelling of the **Holy Spirit** in every Christian. This feast is often called the “**birthday of the Church**.” This is how the gospel illustrates the birthing of the Church:

Jesus said to his disciples: “**Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.**” ...he breathed on them and said to them, “**Receive the Holy Spirit...**”

The **Holy Spirit** is the gift of the **Risen Christ** to us. Our hearts are now the temples of the **Holy Spirit**. We are now well preserved by the holiness of the **Holy Spirit**! We are sealed for eternity! Forevermore!

And today – **Pentecost Sunday**, in order for us to become dynamic witnesses of the **Risen Christ** in the world, at home, at the streets, to wherever we are, and to wherever we go, the **Holy Spirit** will recreate our hearts in this manner:

The **Holy Spirit** will rebuild your hearts as homes of love. And your hearts transfigure you to become “**visible signs of God’s love.**” The **Holy Spirit** is telling you that you are guardians and practitioners of God’s love. And to be the love of Jesus to the world is non-negotiable. You cannot be part-time Christians; you are Christians 24/7.

The **Holy Spirit** will remodel your hearts as homes of prayer. Remember, prayer is the music of the human heart. A community that prays together stays together. Your collective prayers will empower you to continue transforming your Church as a welcoming **HOME**: a **home** where people of various colors, of different opinions, of diverse cultures and varied languages sing the song, “**We are the body of Christ!**”

The **Holy Spirit** will recreate your hearts to become factories of mercy and it will make you “**missionaries of mercy**” ready to “**feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked and shelter the homeless.**”

After the rebuilding, remodeling and recreation of your hearts by the **Holy Spirit**, you will be ready now to shout to God, and say: “**Jesus, set me on fire!**” And Jesus will set you on fire through the words of **Pope Francis**, as he tells you:

“**Go...[set the hearts of Christians on fire]. Be builders of a better world. Don’t be observers of life. Get involved...**”

So, today, **PENTECOST SUNDAY**, as the **Holy Spirit** makes you busybodies in your involvement in spreading the “**Good News**” of the **Risen Christ** to every creature, believe also, that the **Holy Spirit** consecrates you as living saints despite of your sins. And then, act as holy people and live as saints.

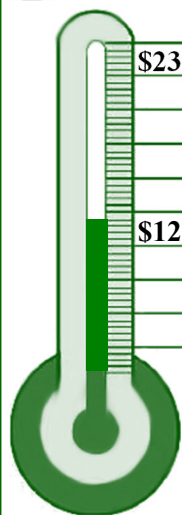

Baskets, Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter. We also help our Brothers and Sisters in need throughout the year.

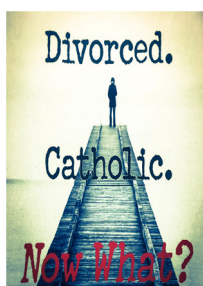
