Dear Holy People of God:

Entangled with personal problems, coupled with works' stress and the world's conundrums, sometimes people will echo the prayer of Elijah: **"This is enough, O Lord! Take my life, for I am no better than my ancestors."** (1Kings 19:4b) But God, hearing a prayer like this, with his unconditional and infinite love, embraces us and sends us his only Son, who will feed us with his life-promising words:

"I am the bread of life. I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever..." (Jn 6:48,51)

When we come to celebrate the **Eucharist**, it is truly a divine encounter with the real presence of the **"bread of life," JESUS!** Indeed, the **Eucharist** is a holy meal of conversion, leading to our personal transfiguration; a holy meal of unity and harmony; and a holy meal of love and forgiveness. The **Eucharist** is a factory of saints!

The **Eucharist** – where the **"bread of life"** is broken and shared, is inclusive and welcoming; it makes us **one body** of Christ! Belongingness in this **one body** is focused on the quality of sharing and not on the quantity of attendees. As **one body**, fulfillment is not gauged according to how much food is eaten but measured on the quality of relationship, service and charity, as we become food to each other. The **Eucharist** is not mechanical and boring but always a celebration of life and love worth remembering.

But today, in this modern and technological world we live in, with our workaholic tendencies, people eat and run. This might be the reason why "fast food" is a major global industry. In fast food restaurants, you can get food fast, eat fast and leave fast.

And sometimes, we carry this practice in Church: rushing becomes our habit. After communion, some leave the Church early - they eat and run. Please remember that the Church is not one of the fast food chains in Chino Hills. It is a sacred place where we celebrate solemnly the **Eucharist**.

So, as we gather around the **Eucharistic table** today, please do create a space in your hearts where Jesus can write his life sustaining words: **"I am the bread of life... [if you] eat this bread, [you] will live forever..."** (Jn 6:41,51)

Today, enjoy this **HOLY MEAL** as a family!
