OUR PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

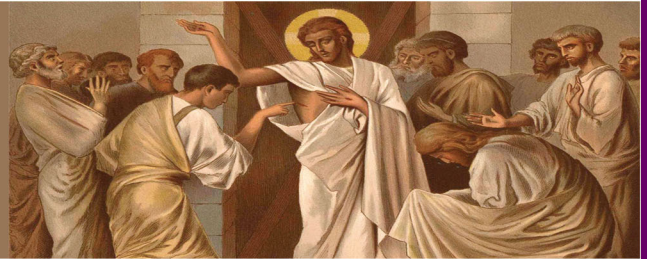

Dear HOLY EASTER PEOPLE of God:

Sensing our troubled world and disturbed hearts, today Jesus greets us with the most elusive words: **"PEACE BE WITH YOU!"** Christ's PEACE is not a fabrication of our imagination. It's a creation of Christ's resurrection. It emanates from his loving, merciful and peaceful heart. Every human heart hungers for it!

This Resurrection PEACE is a blueprint of the Risen Christ's love. It opens our hands to accept the responsibility of PEACEMAKING. It engages us in fostering a community where PEACEMAKERS will be of one heart and one mind. And PEACEKEEPING is the heart's passion for justice and peace!

Fr. Henri Nouwen, one of the greatest spiritual leaders of our times, described in his book, "ROAD TO PEACE," the importance of PEACEMAKING, he said:

"Peacemaking is a full-time vocation that includes each member of God's people... Christians today, if they want to be Christians, have to find the courage to make the word PEACE as important as the word freedom. There should be no doubt in the minds of the people who inhabit this world that Christians are peacemakers.

"A peacemaker prays. Prayer is the beginning and the end, the source and the fruit, the core and the content, the basis and the goal of all PEACEMAKING. I say this without apology, because it allows me to go straight to the heart of the matter...that PEACE IS DIVINE GIFT..."

This Easter Season, embrace that Divine Gift of PEACE, because it is a PEACE that is "not constructed by tough competition, hard thinking, and individual stardom, but rooted in simply being present to each other and working together in harmony." Likewise, "it is often hidden from the wise and the wealthy, and revealed to those who feel empty, inarticulate and poor."

Today, Jesus commissions all of you to be brave **PEACEMAKERS** and daring **PEACE-KEEPERS** in our times, he says:

"Peace be with you! As the father has sent me, so I send you. Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven; and whose sins you retain, they are retained."

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Two Sides of CHRIST'S LOVE

Today's Gospel account reveals the two sides of Christ's love. He mercifully loves us wherever he finds us, even in our sin, but he loves us too much to leave us there and thus calls us to a higher standard.

The Gospel recounts Jesus' first appearance to his disciples after the Resurrection. One of the first things Jesus does is to show them the wounds in his hands and side. These wounds are the effects of sin. The disciples realize their own sinfulness when they see the risen Lord.

But Jesus doesn't come just to show the disciples the effects of sin. He also tells them, "Peace be with you." In the ancient Jewish world "peace" didn't mean just a calm feeling, but it described right relationship and friendship. In coming to meet his friends for the first time since they abandoned him on Good Friday, Jesus not only shows them his wounds, but he speaks words of comfort and forgiveness.

These are the two sides of Christ's love: He comes to show us the truth of our sin and its consequences, but he also comes with mercy and forgiveness. He comes to offer "peace." The place where we experience these two aspects

of Christ's love most profoundly is in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We might be reminded of this sacrament when Jesus tells the apostles that as the Father has sent him, so he now sends them. Jesus was sent by the Father for the forgiveness of sins, and now he is sending his apostles, enabled by the Holy Spirit, to participate in this ministry of forgiveness. Our priests and bishops continue this ministry in the Sacrament of Reconciliation as the successors of the apostles.

Are you ready to avail yourself of both sides of Jesus' love?

DIGGING DEEPER FOR DISCUSSION

With friends or Family, please discuss the following questions:

- **The presenter, Edward Sri, discusses the two sides of Christ's love. What are these two sides, and how do we see Jesus demonstrating both of them in today's Gospel reading?**
- **In what ways do you see Jesus confronting you with both his truth and his mercy in your own life? How do you com-**

monly react to being confronted with the truth of sin? How do you commonly react to being confronted with God's mercy?

PRAYER: Put yourself into today's Gospel reading. Imagine that you are in the upper room with the disciples. Jesus appears to you and shows you the wounds in his hands and in his side—these are the effects of your sins. How do you feel? What do you say to Jesus? Now imagine that Jesus extends his hands toward you and says, "Peace be with you." How do you feel? How would you respond? What do you do when you hear those words?

RESOLUTION: Through the Sacrament of Reconciliation we have direct access to the mission of forgiveness which the Father gave to Jesus and which Jesus shared with the apostles. Make plans to go to Confession as soon as you can. In preparation, prayerfully ask God to reveal any hidden areas of sin in your life and help you to make a good confession.

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Unidos bajo un mismo Espíritu Hch. 5 12-16. La comunidad primitiva se reunía frecuentemente para adorar al Dios del cielo, en el lugar principal y centro de culto, ya establecido desde antiguamente para este propósito. Las sanaciones de los enfermos del pueblo reconocidas como el fruto de estas reuniones, entendidas en forma de signos reales de la unidad del Dios de Jesús con esta comunidad.

En este tiempo de Cuaresma, Dios nos llama a que nos reunamos, no solamente en familia sino también en comunidad y donde exista necesidad “Den, y se les dará, recibirán una medida generosa, apretada, sacudida y rebosante. Porque con la medida que ustedes midan serán medidos,” Lc. 6, 38. Esta lectura la relacionamos con la forma en que nuestros padres nos inculcaron a Dios y la forma como teníamos que vivir la Cuaresma. Nos decían que teníamos que comer ciertas comidas, pero mucho más importante, que teníamos que compartir con los demás. Lo que está sucediendo hoy en nuestros días, desafortunadamente, no es lo que nuestros padres nos enseñaron. Vemos en mí entorno familiar, compañeros de trabajo que no le dan el valor y la importancia que tiene esta temporada de Pascua, argumentando que son otros tiempos, que no existe tiempo para Dios ante un mundo en donde la necesidad de la vida exige vivir a toda prisa. Muchos de nosotros creemos y pensamos que algún día habrá tiempo, pero la realidad pudiera ser otra, tal vez sea que, no deseamos salir de nuestra comodidad, imaginando que tenemos toda una vida garantizada la cual no necesita de Dios. Más aún, estamos completamente convencidos que el tiempo es el mismo, porque Jesús fue, ha sido y seguirá siendo el mismo: Jesús no ha

cambiado. Jesucristo nos amó, nos ama y nos seguirá amando, los que hemos cambiado somos nosotros.

Al igual que aquella comunidad primitiva, Dios nos sigue invitando a reunirnos en comunidad bajo su mismo Espíritu, en armonía; porque como creyentes en el Don maravilloso de la Fe concedido por Nuestro Dios, sentimos la necesidad de corresponder al amor infinito, asistiendo al encuentro, del lugar sagrado, en donde se manifiesta la gloria, en cada acción de gracia realizada por Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, en donde Dios derrama infinidad de dones, no solamente personales sino también comunitarios. Hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, los exhortamos a caminar juntos esta Cuaresma—en unidad todo es posible.

1. Para Hechos: “se les agregó una gran cantidad de hombres y mujeres.” ¿Cómo te preparas para ser un misionero evangelizador en la Iglesia de hoy?
2. Para Apocalipsis: “No tengas miedo.” ¿Cómo compartirías este mensaje con aquellos que están experimentando un momento difícil en sus vidas?
3. Para Juan: “Como el Padre me envió a Mí, yo también los envió a ustedes.” ¿Sientes que este mandamiento es para ti y cuál sería tu respuesta?
4. Para Reflexión: Nuestro bautismo nos hace miembros de la comunidad de la Iglesia. ¿Cómo estás participando en la comunidad de tu parroquia en respuesta a tu bautismo?

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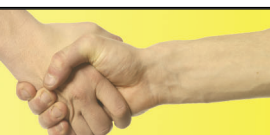
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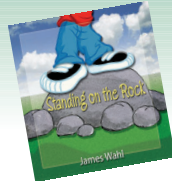
