Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

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Dear HOLY PEOPLE of God:

Today's gospel tells us that, while Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem, someone asked: **"Lord, will only a few people be saved?"** If you are one of those who is thinking not to be saved, reflect on this **"diamond story"** of Dorothy Day:

One day, a well-dressed woman visited the Worker House, and gave a diamond ring to Dorothy. Dorothy thanked the visitor, slipped the ring in her pocket, and later in the day gave it to an old woman who lived alone and often ate her meals at St. Joseph's. One of the staff griped to Dorothy that the ring could better have been sold at the Diamond Exchange and the money can be used to pay the woman's rent for a year. Dorothy replied that the woman had her dignity and could do anything she liked with the ring. She could sell it for rent money or take a trip to the Bahamas. Or she could enjoy having a diamond ring on her hand just like the woman who had brought it to the Worker House. Dorothy Day asked, "Do you suppose that God created diamonds only for the rich?"

Let us rephrase Dorothy's question this way: "Do you suppose that God created heaven only for a few?" I don't think so! You and me are included! Everyone is a "glittering diamond" in God's eyes.

When we sin, God will not abandon us, rather, he will search for us. If we were found, but still plunged into multitude of sins, Christ polishes us with his body and blood so that we can shine like diamonds in God's loving hands. He will lead us to the eternal banquet; and invites us to "recline at God's table!"

And as one of those "glittering diamonds" "reclining at God's table," we are given as God's pledge of love to the world to produce more "glittering diamonds" by committing ourselves to doing the works of mercy:

"To the hungry not only for bread, but hungry for love; to the naked not only for clothing, but naked of human dignity and respect; and to the homeless not only for want of a room of bricks, but homeless because of rejection."

Once our hearts are set in performing the above works of mercy, St. Mother Teresa's words will humbly describe what we can become: **"To grow in likeness of Christ is a sign of holiness."**

**So, you can be a saint...today or someday!
Just believe!**

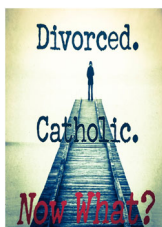

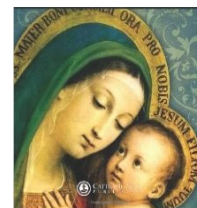
Who can receive the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick?

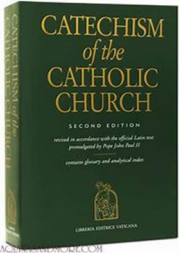

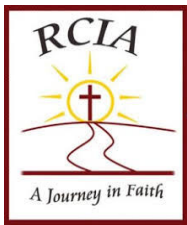

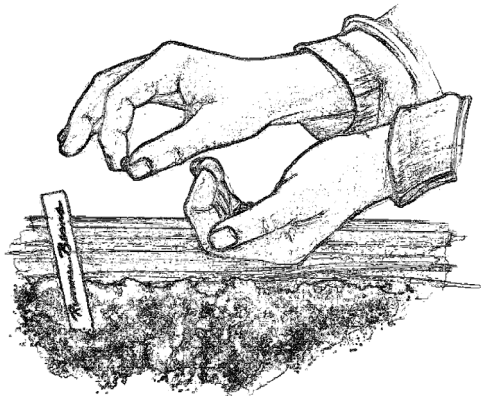
One should enter the process no later than this coming **September 22nd** if expecting to receive their Sacraments at Easter Vigil 2020.

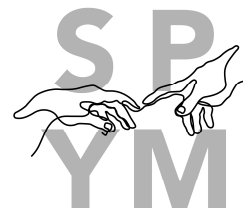

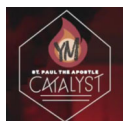

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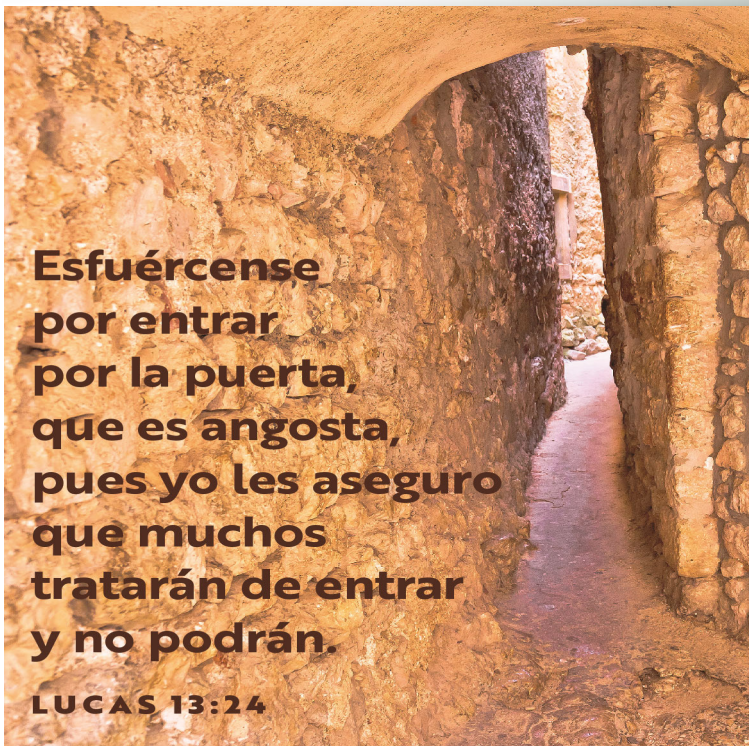

El Antiguo Testamento es la historia de Dios y el pueblo de Israel. Hoy también podemos ver que otros pueblos, “las naciones”, son participantes importantes en la historia. Fue un Medio Oriente poblado y otras naciones como Egipto, Canaán y Babilonia que a menudo estaban observando los encuentros de Dios con Israel. Ellos atestiguaron el juicio de Dios hacia Israel y la restauración de Dios hacia Israel (Ezequiel 36). La reputación de Dios se propagó ampliamente en medio de ellos. Dios los gobernó y los bendijo (Salmo 47, Salmo 67).

En la lectura de hoy de Isaías, el autor presenta una visión en la que todas las naciones, un día, estarán reunidas para adorar a Dios. Ellas serán aceptados en la casa de Dios como miembros plenos y bendecidas con la salvación de Dios (Isaías 56, Isaías 19). La intención de Dios todo el tiempo fue formar a Israel para invitar a “las naciones” a participar en el plan grande. Cuando Dios primero llamó a Abraham, Dios dijo: “te bendeciré. . . Todas las familias de la tierra encontrarán la bendición en ti” (Génesis 12). Nosotros, la Iglesia de hoy, compartimos este llamado.

EL ÚLTIMO Y EL PRIMERO

La frase de Jesús en el Evangelio de Lucas de

hoy, “los que ahora son los últimos, serán los primeros; y los que ahora son los primeros, serán los últimos”, también está de una manera parecida en Mateo (20:16) y Marcos (10:31). Todas ellas son frases con las que concluye una enseñanza de Jesús, pero cada una de ellas está en un contexto diferente. En Mateo, la frase concluye la parábola de los trabajadores de la huerta, molestando a las expectativas de los oyentes acerca del trabajo y su salario. En Marcos, la riqueza se presenta como un obstáculo para la salvación, una vez más revirtiendo las expectativas.

En Lucas, cuando se le pregunta si solo algunos se salvarán, Jesús cambia el énfasis de quién es la mejor persona para recibir esa invitación de Dios. Siguiendo la sanación de la mujer en día sábado (13:11-17), Jesús enfatiza la compasión sobre la estricta interpretación de la ley judía. Sorprende a las personas que lo están escuchando, Jesús anuncia que quienes sean compasivos, en lugar de aquellos en posiciones de liderazgo religioso, serán los primeros en entender y aceptar la salvación de Dios.
