YOUR HOLY FAMILY

Families come in all shapes and sizes. When asked to describe your family, you might begin by telling people about a parent, sibling, or extended family members. You might even describe what you have learned from a genealogical study. You are unlikely, however, no matter how wonderful your family may be, to describe your family as "holy." And yet, this is our primary call. Each of us as people of God, and each of our families, is called to be holy. We are called to live as God's people in the world, to communicate God's love and presence through the way that we live together and in relationship with others. Every family, no matter what their circumstances, is called to be a holy family. Even Mary, Joseph and Jesus faced challenges and trials. And yet they rose to the occasion, listened to and followed God's will, and were assured of the love of the Lord through it all.

BECOMING CATHOLIC: RCIA

RCIA is the process in which Adults are brought into the Catholic Church by receiving the **Sacraments of Initiation...**

Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil. The process lasts at least one liturgical year and involves a series of **Rites**, study, retreat and discussions.



If you wish to join the Catholic Community and participate in the Sacraments, or know a family member or friend who may be interested in becoming a Catholic, the RCIA Ministry is open year-round to begin the process.

Minding Our Manners: Church Etiquette



Manners are like the zero in arithmetic; they may not be much in themselves, but they are capable of adding a great deal to the value of everything else. - F. Stark

The first lessons in manners are taught to children by members of the family at home. These early lessons in etiquette are generally the ones used at the table, the way in which one family member speaks to others, the manner in which items in the house are to be respected and maintained, the art of sharing and many other aspects of social behavior.

Children should be taught that being polite does not mean that they cannot be honest. Thinking before they speak out can help ease an otherwise awkward situation. During an argument we often say things without thinking that are not meant but are so very difficult to take back.

CHURCH ETIQUETTE

It's never too early to begin helping children to understand that Christians are thoughtful people and etiquette is a form of thoughtfulness. In church parents can reflect this by:

- arriving before Mass begins.
- filling in the places closest to the altar first. (Children can also see better from here.)
- avoiding having people climb over you and your family to get to a place.
- being attentive and by participating fully-say the words and sing!
- wearing clothing appropriate for the occasion.
- being friendly and greeting the celebrant and other parishioners after Mass.

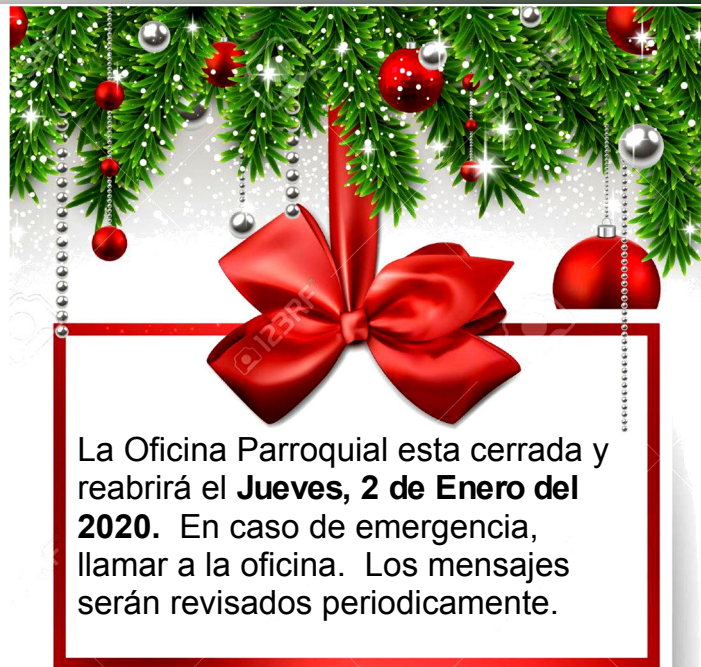

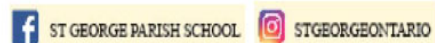
