DEAR HOLY PEOPLE OF GOD:

Today's gospel is a revealing scenario of **trust** expressed in words, and an illuminating picture of **life** conveyed in action. Read the gospel with the eyes of your faith:

Jesus said to his disciples, "**It is I; do not be afraid!**" Peter said to him in reply, "**Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water.**" Jesus said, "**Come.**" Peter got out of the boat and began to walk on the water toward Jesus. But when he saw how strong the wind was he became frightened; and, beginning to sink, he cried out, "**Lord, save me!**" Jesus **stretched out his hand** and caught Peter..."

Focus your attention to Jesus' words and action. He said to the disciples: "**It is I; do not be afraid.**" And after being invited to "**come,**" Peter walked towards Jesus. When Peter started to sink, fear enveloped him, and he cried out, "**Lord, save me!**" Jesus **stretched out his hand** and saved Peter.

Jesus' words "**It is I; do not be afraid**" are expressions of trust and faith: the woman caught in adultery trusted Jesus and she opened her life to him, and she was forgiven; the paralytic exhibited his faith, and he was healed.

Jesus' "**outstretched hands**" are suppliers of hope and life: he welcomed sinners, tax collectors, and prostitutes, and their hearts were enveloped by hope; he touched the lepers, and they were cleansed and have a second life.

How about us? What kind of words do we tell people? What kind of hands do we stretch out to them? Sometimes, our words are poisons that destroy relationship and reputation of others. Sometimes, we stretched out our hands to others, and say, "**welcome**" or "**peace,**" but deep in our hearts hostile attitudes still exist.

But today, we the Christians in this planet, we can change the image of our world. We are not factory defects, but completely God's creation in his own image and likeness. Therefore, we have that divine dignity to hang on. Like Jesus, let's be daring to stretch out our hands to a friend, family members, people in need, even to our enemies, and sincerely say the words, "**I LOVE YOU!**" or to assure them security and friendship, and say: "**It is I; do not be afraid!**"

Today, as God's words of hope and hands of life, our mission then is to be:

a world class Catholic -
by telling words that bring blessings and hope;
that take away fear and guilt;
that bring unity, forgiveness and healing;
and by stretching out our hands
as suppliers of life, love and faith in people's hearts


**ANNOUNCEMENT

REMINDER FOR WEEKEND MASSES

As a reminder to those who have chosen to once again join us for the “live and in person,” **outdoor** celebrations of the Mass, we do remind you of the following to help keep you healthy and safe during these liturgical celebrations:

As we are now in the summer months and the outdoor temperatures can reach **very** high numbers, and knowing that there may be little to no shade in the area where the outdoor Masses are celebrated, we highly encourage **everyone** to bring the following with you:

- * **Sunscreen**
- * **Sunglasses**
- * **Hats**
- * **Footwear** appropriate for an outdoor setting (e.g., tennis shoes – ladies, no high heels since we are **outdoors** and the surfaces can be **very** uneven)
- * **Bottled water**
- * **Hand Sanitizer**

The following items are **not** permitted:

- * **Umbrellas**
- * **Personal Fans**

- ◆ **Everyone** over the age of 2 years, **must** wear a face **mask** throughout the entire celebration which covers the nose and mouth (**Note:** this mask may only be removed at the moment when one is receiving the Eucharist/Communion, and then must be placed back over the nose and mouth after the Eucharist has been consumed).
- ◆ Please note that, at this time, restrooms will be for **emergency use only**.
- ◆ For those who may be prone to heat/sun stroke, you are cautioned to consider your participation in the outdoor Mass **very carefully**. We will still be broadcasting the Livestream Masses on Saturday evening and Sunday morning.

RECORDATORIO PARA LAS MISAS DE FIN DE SEMANA

Como recordatorio para aquellos que han optado a unirse una vez más a nosotros para las celebraciones al aire libre "en vivo y en persona" de la Misa, le recordamos lo siguiente para ayudarlo a mantenerse sano y seguro durante estas celebraciones litúrgicas:

Como estamos ahora en los meses de verano y las temperaturas exteriores pueden alcanzar números muy altos, y sabiendo que puede haber poca o ninguna sombra en el área donde se celebran las Misas al aire libre, pedimos a todos que traigan lo siguiente:

- * Protector solar
- * Gafas para el sol
- * Sombreros
- * Zapatos apropiados para afuera (ejemplo, tenis, damas, no tacones ya que estamos **afuera** y los suelos están muy irregulares).
- * Botella de agua
- * Desinfectante para las manos

Los siguientes son objetos **no** permitidos:

- * Sombrillas
- * Abanicos personales

- ◆ Toda persona de más de 2 años **debe** usar **máscara facial** durante toda la celebración que cubra la nariz y la boca (**Nota:** esta máscara facial solo se puede quitar en el momento en que se reciba la Eucaristía/Comunión, y luego se debe volver a colocar sobre la nariz y la boca después de que se haya consumido la Eucaristía).
- ◆ Tenga en cuenta que, en este momento, los baños serán **solo para uso de emergencia**.
- ◆ Para aquellos quienes tal vez sean propensos al calor/insolación, deben tener precaución y considerar muy cuidadosamente su participación en la Misa al aire libre. Seguiremos transmitiendo las Misas en vivo el sábado por la noche y el domingo por la mañana.



SAINT TERESA BENEDICTA OF THE CROSS (EDITH STEIN) (1891-1942)

“Come,” Edith gently whispered, taking her sister Rosa’s hand, “let us go for our people!” These were Edith Stein’s last words as the Nazis, enraged at the Dutch bishops’ condemnation of their genocide, took into custody all Catholic converts from Judaism. Born Jewish, but non-practicing from her teens, Edith’s search for truth led to a doctorate in philosophy, a brilliant career as professor and author and, finally, to the *Autobiography of Saint Teresa of Ávila*, which she read in one sitting, then declared, “That is the Truth!” Baptized on January 1, 1922, observed then as the feast of Jesus’ initiation into the covenant of Abraham, confirmed on February 2, the feast of Jesus’ Presentation in the Temple, Edith entered the cloistered Carmelites in Cologne, transferring to a convent in Holland when she realized that, because of the Nazi persecution of the Jews, her presence could imperil the safety of the other nuns. She died in the gas chambers of Auschwitz as a daughter of Israel and of the Church.

En el Evangelio de Mateo, Pedro a menudo sirve como una representación de los otros discípulos de Jesús y de todas las personas que se esfuerzan por seguir a Jesús. Cuando Pedro desea imitar a Jesús caminando sobre las aguas en medio de una tormenta, quizá deseado mostrar cuán fuerte su fe es, él enfrenta sus propias limitaciones y su necesidad de ser rescatado por Jesús, quien luego le dice a Pedro con ternura y también con un desafío: “Oh tu poca fe”. Jesús acepta la frágil y limitada fe de Pedro y la de los otros discípulos y los ama incondicionalmente.

La Iglesia primitiva se identificó con Pedro, como personas con “poca” fe. La fe de ellos no estaba completamente madura, o tan extraordinaria como la fe que de otros podría parecer. Pero sabían que su fe, por pequeña o imperfecta que fuera, era real y verdadera. Podríamos recordar que nuestra propia poca “fe” es apreciada por Dios. Dios nos ama tal como somos y siempre busca formarnos hacia una vida cristiana de fe completamente madura.

ENRAIZADO EN LA FIDELIDAD DE DIOS

El pasaje de la carta de san Pablo a los romanos comienza con una reflexión extensa, en los

capítulos 9 al 11, de la aceptación de Pablo a la recepción variada pero generalmente negativa de sus compañeros judíos hacia su proclamación de Cristo. Desde luego él se preocupaba por el pueblo judío, y también por los miembros de los primeros cristianos que eran tanto judíos como no judíos. Su preocupación principal era que su fe cristiana siempre debería estar enraizada en la fidelidad de Dios. Así que Pablo rechazó cualquier noción que Dios de alguna manera había abandonado a Israel o la alianza de Dios con ellos.

Como lo confirma la enseñanza católica, especialmente el Concilio Vaticano II, la Iglesia comparte con el pueblo judío la tradición de la fidelidad de Dios. Debemos reconocer y arrepentirnos de la participación y complicidad de la Iglesia en la oscuridad del antisemitismo, tanto en el pasado como hoy. Rezamos continuamente con y por el pueblo judío como nuestros hermanos y hermanas en la fe.


