



he END and THE BEGINNING—

To mark the beginning of our faith at Jesus' glorious Resurrection! The precursor to this event is the

TRIDUUM—the three days that come at the end of Lent; the days that mark the Paschal Mystery of Redemption.

DAY ONE: HOLY THURSDAY

The Last Supper held in the upper room with Jesus washing the feet of his disciples and instituting the 1st Eucharist celebration.

DAY TWO: GOOD FRIDAY

The death of Jesus on the cross.

DAY THREE: HOLY SATURDAY

Hopes of a Messiah have been destroyed and all forget momentarily that God has a plan for the morning!

Did you know . . .

Easter Eggs are a tradition used to symbolize the Risen Christ and new life. As Easter approaches consider:

- Europe has domesticated hens since 600 B.C.?
- while it is customary to throw rice weddings in many countries, French brides break an egg on the threshold of their new home before stepping in, for luck and healthy babies?
- by today's count there are 200 breeds of chickens?
- you can spin an egg to tell if it is raw or hard-cooked? If it spins easily, it is hard-cooked; if it wobbles it is raw.
- there are about 240 million laying hens that lay 50 billion eggs each year in the **U. S.**—one hen for every man, woman and child?
- in **Germany**, a popular Easter tradition is the "egg tree"? A small tree branch is put in a vase about two weeks before Easter, and eggs that have been painted and decorated are hung from the branch to celebrate birth and blessings?
- in Italy, church bells ring joyfully during the year but stop on the Thursday before Good Friday? They remain silent through the next few days while people remember the death of Jesus. On Easter Sunday they return for the Resurrection.
- in **France**, children roll raw eggs down a small hill to see which will reach the bottom without breaking? The surviving egg is said to symbolize the stone being rolled away from the tomb.



MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO – ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

Hoy empezamos la Semana Santa o Semana Mayor. Las lecturas de la liturgia de hoy nos presentan la entrada solemne de Jesús a Jerusalén y el relato de su Pasión. Las lecturas invitan realmente a entrar con Jesús a la ciudad y hacer de estos importantes días verdaderamente santos. Su entrada triunfal es de júbilo y paz, no de guerra y violencia. Montado en un burrito, no sobre un caballo de ejército. "Los discípulos se fueron e hicieron como Jesús les había mandado. Le trajeron la burra con su cría, le colocaron sus mantos sobre el lomo y él se sentó encima" (Mateo 21,6-7). La gente gritaba y se apretujaba por seguirlo. "¡Hosana al hijo de David! ¡Bendito sea el que viene en el nombre del Señor! ¡Hosana en lo más alto de los cielos!" (Mateo 21,9).

¿Quiénes de todos los que ahora lo alaban, gritarán en su contra el Viernes Santo? ¿Cuántos en la actualidad se avergüenzan de seguir y pertenecer a Jesús? La fe es para manifestarse en público y en privado. Se está con Jesús en momentos de júbilo y en momentos de su Pasión. Así es el ejemplo de este Domingo de Ramos, al principio de la Eucaristía se proclama el Evangelio de la entrada triunfante de Jesús a la ciudad y enseguida se proclama la Pasión del Señor. Triunfo y sufrimiento, júbilo y dolor, así es la existencia humana. Nuestra tarea en esta Semana Santa, es reflexionar en cuantas personas crucificadas están a nuestro alrededor. Y a la vez llevar a ellas la esperanza de la Pascua que ya viene.


