PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

We, the people of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Faith Community, Baptized into Jesus Christ, formed by Word and Sacrament, and Empowered by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, Seek to be a visible sign of God's love. We seek to build the Kingdom of God by: Using our unique gifts to minister to one another, Welcoming all and caring for those in need, Teaching our faith to others and Uniting in worship as a family with the Body of Christ.

Dear St. Paul Family and Friends,

On November 1st, the Catholic Church celebrates the **Holy day of Obligation of All Saints Day**. We celebrate all those in heaven, the famous saints who have been canonized, as well as the many "saints next door" who have not been canonized. We focus on their virtues. We ask for their intercession.

We all know that the saints are great teachers of the Christian life. Most appropriately, as we are journeying through a Eucharistic Revival, we are able to see in them the impact the Holy Eucharist is meant to have in our life. Pope Benedict XVI says: "The Eucharist is at the root of every form of holiness, and each of us is called to the fullness of life in the Holy Spirit. How many saints have advanced along the way of perfection thanks to their Eucharistic devotion! From [18 saints and blessed] to name only a few, holiness has always found its center in the sacrament of the Eucharist." (Sacramentum Caritatis 94)

The saints show us how to make Jesus - really, truly, and substantially present in the Holy Eucharist — the source, summit, root and center of our life. They teach us how to unite ourselves in Holy Communion with Him who is "Holy, Holy, Holy," and how to allow that holiness to flow in the communion of a Eucharistic life.

We can look into the life of Blessed Carlo Acutis (1991 -2016), the second co-patron of the Eucharistic Revival. He is the first millennial to be raised to the altars. After receiving his first Communion at 7, he became thereafter a daily Mass goer until he died of acute promyeolocytic leukemia at 15. When he would receive Holy Communion, he would pray in thanksgiving: "Jesus, come right in! Make yourself at home!" Further, he said, "I think that many people do not fully understand the value of the Mass, because if they recognized the enormous blessing we have in a Lord who gives himself as our food and drink in the Sacred Host, they would go to Mass every day to participate in the fruits of the sacrifice and let go of so many superfluous things."



In a "Holiness kit" he made for the students he taught in catechism, he wrote: "Try to go every day to Mass and to receive Holy Communion... If you can, stay a few minutes every day in Eucharistic adoration in front of the tabernacle where Jesus is really present, and you will see your level of holiness increase considerably."

At the age of 11, he learned computer programming to build websites to catalogue and promote Eucharistic miracles. He researched and wrote about them until they grew to a 196-part series. In 2005, it was exhibited in the Vatican during a conference on Eucharistic miracles during the Year of the Eucharist. He sums up the necessity and beauty of the Eucharist: "The Eucharist is my highway to heaven." "The more often we receive the Eucharist, the more we become like Jesus."

EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT FOR HOLY SOULS – FIRST FRIDAY - NOVEMBER 3RD



November is set aside by the Church to pray for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. There is an abundance of graces that can be attained for the Holy Souls through the Catholic Church. In the Handbook of Indulgences, Norms and Grants, it states:

"A partial indulgence is granted for the Christian faithful when they visit the Blessed Sacrament for the purpose of adoration. When this is done for at least half hour, the indulgence is a **plenary one.**"

Indulgences may only be applied to ourselves or to a Holy Soul in Purgatory. In order to receive the Plenary Indulgence, one must be completely detached from sin, must have gone to confession, received Holy Communion and prayed for the intentions of the Holy Father, (eg., Our Father and Hail Mary).

St. Paul the Apostle has Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament every day in the Chapel, Monday through Friday after morning Mass until 6:00 pm. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

On First Friday, November 3rd, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the Church after the 8:00 a.m. Mass until 4:30 p.m.

Come and pray to flood extra graces to your soul and to the Souls of the Faithfully Departed. For those who want to offer more for the Holy Souls in November:

"An indulgence is granted for the Christian faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, if only mentally, for the dead. This indulgence is applicable **only to the souls in purgatory**. This indulgence is a plenary one from **November 1**st **through November 8**th and can be gained on each one of these days. On other days of the year this indulgence is a partial one". Handbook of Indulgences, Norms and Grants, In order to receive the indulgence, one must go to confession, be detached from sin, receive Holy Communion and pray for the Intentions of the Holy Father, as stated above.



Hoy, Liturgia, nos habla mandamientos que son inseparables el uno del otro. El amor a Dios y el amor al prójimo, dos puntos fundamentales del Evangelio de hoy. "Amarás al Señor tu Dios con tu corazón, con toda tu alma y con toda tu mente. Este es el gran mandamiento, el primero. Pero hay otro muy parecido: Amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo. Toda la Ley y los profetas se fundamentan en estos dos mandamientos (Mateo 22,37-40).

"En el Evangelio de hoy, una vez más, Jesús nos ayuda a ir a la fuente viva y que brota del Amor. Y tal fuente es Dios mismo, para ser amado totalmente en una comunión que nada ni nadie puede romper. 


