## PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

We, the people of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Faith Community, baptized into Jesus Christ, formed by Word and Sacrament, and empowered by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, seek to be a visible sign of God's love. We to build the Kingdom of God by: Using our unique gifts to minister to one another, welcoming all and caring for those in need, teaching our faith to others and uniting in worship as a family with the Body of Christ.

Dear People of God:

This weekend, we start with the Rite of Scrutiny of the Elect after they have publicly expressed their desire for baptism to our Bishop Alberto Rojas, D.D. during the Rite of Election.

### What are the Scrutinies?

The Rite of Scrutinies are held on the third, fourth, and fifth Sundays of Lent. These rites, with roots dating back to the early Church, take place during the Sunday Mass, each thematically linked to the Gospel reading (we will be using Year A) of the three passages from St. John's Gospel which teaches the elect about the mystery of sin, and fill them with the Spirit of Christ.

1. **Third Sunday of Lent**, First Scrutiny (the Samaritan Woman at the well) tells us that Christ is the Living Water,
2. **Fourth Sunday of Lent**, Second Scrutiny (healing of the man born blind), tells us that Christ is the Light of the World,
3. **Fifth Sunday of Lent**, Third Scrutiny (the raising of Lazarus from the dead), tells us that Christ is the Resurrection and the Life.

The 'Elect' along with their sponsors, kneel before the celebrant and the assembly, who pray for them silently with a series of intercessions. It culminates in a prayer of cleansing and protection (exorcism) with the laying-on-of-hands.

The Scrutinies are God's way of taking a close, loving look at the 'Elect'. The Church teaches that the purpose of the scrutinies is "to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect, to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good. For the scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver the elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way,



the truth, and the life. These rites, therefore, should complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all." (RCIA141)

Therefore, the scrutinies help the 'Elect' complete their conversion and deepen their resolve to become disciples. This "scrutinizing" happens in a two-part movement. "First, the elect are instructed gradually about the mystery of sin [by the gospel], from which the whole world and every person longs to be delivered and thus saved. Second, their spirit is filled with Christ the Redeemer, who is the living water, the light of the world, and the resurrection and the life." (RCIA 143)

Let us continue then to pray for our 'Elect' that they may continue to be strengthened and be inspired more by the Word of God, and we look forward for that day when they'll be in full communion with Christ's body, the Church and be one with us in the celebration of the Holy Eucharist.

Mark was baptized Catholic, but grew up in an agnostic household not practicing the faith, and has since gone through a conversion. He became a devout believer and evangelist after experiencing what he believes are a series of miracles in his life. Today, Mark is committed to openly sharing his faith using the talents he has acquired after a lifetime in the real estate industry.

### April 2nd—Bishop Alberto Rojas—The Jubilee Year of Hope

Bishop Rojas will embolden us on our journey for this Jubilee Year of Hope with special emphasis on the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy

Bishop Rojas was ordained a priest in 1997 in Chicago and was appointed Auxiliary Bishop of the Chicago archdiocese in 2011. Pope Francis appointed Bishop Rojas as the Coadjutor Bishop of San Bernardino in December of 2019 and he is now serving as the Third Ordinary Bishop of the Diocese of San Bernardino. Bishop Rojas has served on five committees of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. His motto is "Nos basta el amor de Dios—God's love is all we need".

### April 9th—Reverend Christopher Smith—The What and the How of Hope

What is Christian hope anyway? As Catholics how do we nourish a foundation of hope to call upon especially when life sends us to the wilderness of discouragement, doubt and fear?

Fr. Christopher has served as a priest of the Diocese of Orange since 1978. He has served in many capacities in the Diocese of Orange, including Parochial Vicar, Director of the Office and Vicar for Religious Education, Pastor of St. Joseph Church, Episcopal Vicar for Priests, and Director of the Ministry to Priests Office. He was the first Rector of Christ Cathedral and is now the Rector Emeritus.

“Ở dưới bầu trời này, mọi sự đều có lúc, mọi việc đều có thời” (Gv 3:1). Những lời quen thuộc này, trích từ sách Giảng Viên. Mọi sự việc xảy ra trong đời chúng ta đều có một “trật tự linh thiêng” theo thời gian của nó. Đây là một sự thật mà ai ai trong chúng ta cũng đều cảm nghiệm từ đáy lòng, dù cho chúng ta rất muốn nắm quyền điều khiển đời mình. Cái “trật tự linh thiêng” này càng quan trọng hơn khi chúng ta bước vào sự linh thiêng của việc cầu nguyện. Câu 7 của sách Giảng Viên nói tiếp: “một thời để làm thinh, một thời để lên tiếng.” Chúng ta biết rằng cầu nguyện là một cuộc nói chuyện hai chiều với Chúa. Hành trình Mùa Chay không chỉ nhằm dẫn chúng ta quay trở lại quá khứ để ăn năn khóc lóc tội lỗi mình hay đến toà giải tội xưng thú tội lỗi mình... nhưng còn muốn dẫn chúng ta đến cuộc sống mới dồi dào hơn. Mùa Chay phải trở thành mùa đổi mới con người và xã hội, mùa nở hoa kết trái tình thương, mùa thực thi việc lành phúc đức... nếu không, chúng ta cũng sẽ bị tiêu diệt y như vậy hoặc có thể “năm tới sẽ bị chặt đi”. Lạy Chúa Giêsu Kitô, Chúa luôn tiếp tục mời gọi chúng con gặp gỡ Chúa một cách sâu đậm hơn. Xin cho chúng con luôn hăng hái đáp lại lời mời gọi của Chúa. 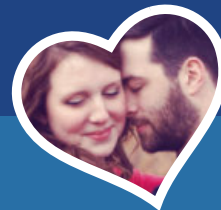
