PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

We, the people of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Faith Community, baptized into Jesus Christ, formed by Word and Sacrament, and empowered by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, seek to be a visible sign of God's love. We seek to build the Kingdom of God by: Using our unique gifts to minister to one another, welcoming all and caring for those in need, teaching our faith to others and uniting in worship as a family with the Body of Christ.

Dear People of God:

As we enter this 5th Sunday of Lent, we are also on the third Sunday of Scrutiny of the Elect. We are reminded to continue to pray for them that through this last scrutiny, they begin their final walk towards the baptismal font where they will "die in their old self" and finally embrace the "newness of life" in Jesus.

This final Sunday of Lent, we somehow feel the frustrations and grief of Martha who tells Jesus "If you had been here, my brother would not have died..." (John 11:21) Whether she's confessing her faith to Jesus who could have healed her brother Lazarus or accuses Jesus of being neglectful of their brother, Jesus assures her of one thing, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die." (John 1:25).

First, death is unavoidable and all of us might have that fear in face of death. But how can we have resurrection if there's no death? We have to allow our old, sinful lives to undergo certain death for us to receive the newness of life in Jesus.

Second, whatever difficult circumstances we are in right now, whether inside the "stinky tomb" of despair or "wrapped with burial cloth" of grief, Jesus is calling us just as he calls Lazarus, "Come out there!"

Third, when Lazarus came out from the tomb, just as Jesus told the people to "untie him and let him go," we have a community to help us out be freed and be untied with whatever ceases us to move forward in this life.

Jesus is offering us a chance to embrace new life in him, filled with God's grace and mercy.



Remember, Jesus told the Samaritan woman at the well that he is the Messiah, to the man born blind that he is the Son of Man and today, he tells Martha that he is the resurrection and the life. There is just this question Jesus is asking us just as he asked Martha: "Do you believe this?"

Recalling the theme of the liturgical readings on the three Sundays of scrutiny, each theme guides and examines the Elect on how they relate with Jesus as the **Living Water** (Samaritan woman at the well), as the **Light of the World** (Healing of the man born blind) and as the **Resurrection and the Life** (the raising of Lazarus from the dead). This is a journey of the Elect and our own journey as a community, in which through the Word, we are challenged to renew our hope in Jesus who quenches our thirst, transforms our darkness into light and assures us that death is not the end but there is a resurrection to life eternal.




LENTEN PASSAGE HUNT



AGES 18-39

Người tin vào Chúa sẽ từng bước trưởng thành để thuộc về Chúa Kitô hoàn toàn. Thánh Phaolô đã dùng cách nói "được Chúa Kitô chiếm đoạt" để diễn tả sự biến đổi của người tín hữu, trở nên đồng hình đồng

dạng với Chúa Giêsu. Quả vậy, đời sống đức tin chính là cuộc chạy đua liên lỉ. Mỗi người phải quên đi mọi sự để chỉ chú tâm về đích, lao mình về phía trước. Nơi đích điểm ấy, có Chúa đang chờ đợi chúng ta (Bài đọc II).

Thiên Chúa không lên án chúng ta. Ngài luôn yêu thương và rộng lượng thứ tha mọi tội lỗi ta đã phạm, miễn là chúng ta thành tâm

trở về với Ngài. Đức Thánh Cha Phanxicô đã khẳng định một danh xưng của Thiên Chúa: "Danh Ngài là Thương Xót".

Khi tuyên bố: "Ai trong các ông sạch tội, cứ việc lấy đã mà ném trước đi!", Chúa Giêsu nhắc bảo chúng ta hãy nhìn lại mình, trước khi kết án phê bình người khác. Bởi lẽ trên trần gian, không ai là hoàn thiện.

Ng li phi ni trong Tin Mung hôm nay đi din cho tít ci chúng ta, những tội nhân. Cách nào đó, chúng ta cũng là những người ngoại tình trước mặt Thiên Chúa, là những kẻ phản bội lòng trung tín của Ngài. Kinh nghiệm

của chị cũng tượng trưng cho ý định của Thiên Chúa dành cho tất cả chúng ta: Thiên Chúa không kết án chúng ta nhưng cứu độ chúng ta nhờ Đức Giêsu. Đức Giêsu chính là ân sủng, cứu vớt chúng ta khỏi tội lỗi và cái chết. Ngài đã lấy ngón tay viết trên đất, trên cái bụi mà từ đó con người được tạo dựng nên (x. St 2,7). Phán quyết của Thiên

Chúa là: 'Ta không muốn con phải chết, nhưng muốn con được sống.' Chúa không cứ tội ta mà trách phạt, cũng chẳng đồng nhất ta với những lỗi lầm trót phạm. Chúa muốn giải thoát chúng ta. Chúa muốn ở với ta và muốn chúng ta cũng ở lại với Ngài. Chúa mong ước chúng ta đừng sử dụng tự do để làm điều xấu nhưng biết làm điều thiện. Và chúng ta có thể làm được điều ấy với ân sủng Chúa ban.


