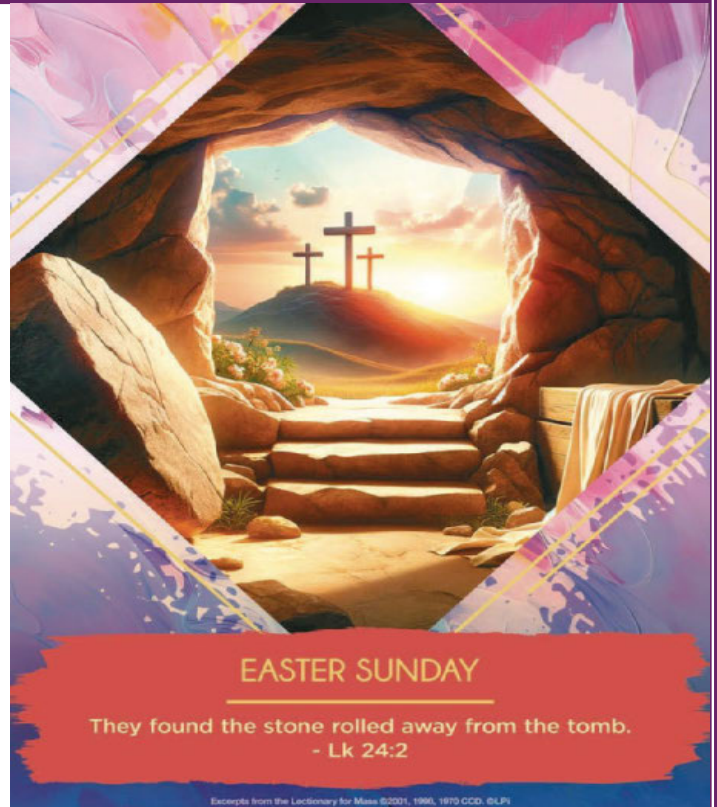
Dear People of God:

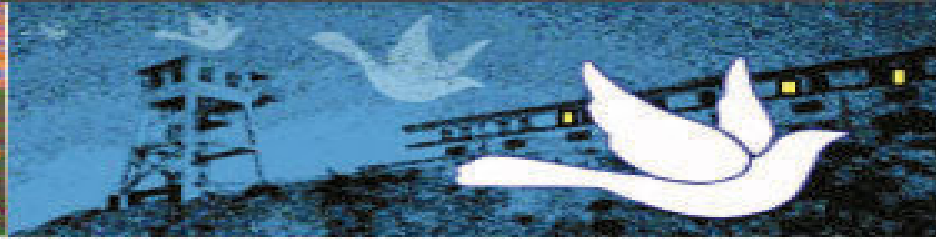

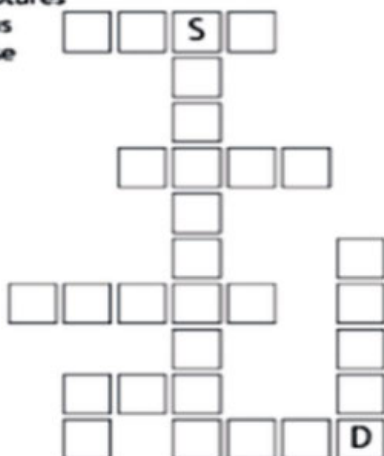

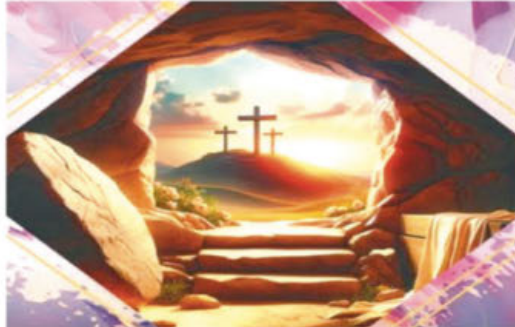

AGES 18-39

Anh chị em thân mến! Ngày trọng đại, vui mừng mang nhiều ý nghĩa, nhất của Kitô Giáo, đó là ngày đại lễ Phục Sinh hôm nay. Ngày đại lễ, làm cho các ngày khác như lễ Giáng Sinh có ý nghĩa. Nếu như Chúa không sống lại từ cõi chết thì tất cả nền tảng đức tin của chúng ta hoàn toàn sụp đổ, vô ý nghĩa, cuộc khổ nạn, bị đóng đinh vào Thập Giá của Chúa Kitô, trở thành một tin buồn khủng khiếp, chứ không phải là Tin Mừng.

Vì thế, mỗi Thánh lễ Chúa nhật, chúng ta đều tưởng niệm biến cố Chúa Phục Sinh: Chúa hiện diện giữa chúng ta và trao ban lương thực thiêng liêng nuôi dưỡng linh hồn chúng ta. Trong sự chết và sự phục sinh của Đức Giêsu, niềm hy vọng chiến thắng sự thất vọng. Kể từ khi Chúa Giêsu chịu treo trên thập giá, cây gỗ gồm một thanh ngang và một thanh dọc đã trở thành biểu tượng của hy vọng đối với các Kitô hữu.



Đây không phải là sự ru ngủ, mua chuộc hay mê dân. Trái lại, niềm hy vọng đến từ quyền năng của Thiên Chúa. Hãy nhìn xem hai người trộm bị đóng đinh cùng với Chúa Giêsu: một người khước từ

tin vào Chúa và thậm chí phê phán thách thức Người; trái lại, người kia lại cầu xin với lòng thành tin cậy trông. Người "trộm lành" đã được Chúa hứa ban thiên đàng ngay ngày hôm đó. Sự kiện này nhắc nhở chúng ta: dù tội lỗi đến đâu cũng không mất niềm hy vọng vào lòng thương xót của Thiên Chúa.

Ngày hôm nay, Đức Giêsu Phục sinh đến nâng đỡ những ai đang kiếm tìm chân lý và ý nghĩa cuộc đời, nhất là các bạn trẻ. Người khẳng định: "Chính Thầy là con đường, là sự thật và là sự sống. Không ai đến với Chúa Cha mà không qua Thầy" (Ga 14,16).

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

El Señor Jesús vive y de ello damos testimonio porque hemos sido testigos de su Resurrección. La presencia del resucitado llena de alegría todas las cosas y al mundo entero. ¡Ha cumplido su palabra; está vivo! *"Entonces entró también el otro discípulo, el que había llegado primero, vio y creyó. Pues no habían entendido todavía la Escritura: él debía resucitar de entre los muertos"* (Juan 20:8-10). Jesús ya nunca volverá a morir, ¡Cristo Resucitó! ¡Verdaderamente Resucitó! ¿Crees esto? Es el saludo de este gozo pascual de este Domingo de Pascua.

Todos los bautizados debemos de estar alegres porque, por el hecho de ser bautizados, somos hijos e hijas de Dios, herederos del cielo, miembros de la Iglesia y por lo tanto estamos llamados a resucitar con él. 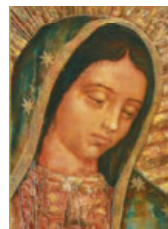

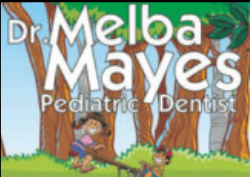

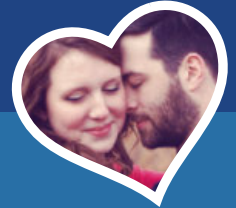
