My Dear People of God:

During our recent annual La Salette HI-CA District retreat and meeting, our facilitator, Fr. James Henault, MS mentioned about huge turn out of mass attendees during special occasions. He said, "Why do people flock the Church during Christmas and Easter? Because they have that little faith in their hearts. Why don't they come back to Church on other Sundays? Because we have little faith to let them back." In my personal reflections on those words, I realized that there is also one thing that can be added with those thoughts, "We do not have big love for the little faith that they have."

This Second Sunday of Easter, the Risen Christ showed Himself to his disciples, who, for fear of the Jews had locked themselves in, He greeted them saying, "Peace be with you!" Jesus knew that His disciples were still struggling to understand what just had happened few days ago, and so He wanted to bring peace to their grieving hearts. They might have lost every confidence that they have in Jesus, that is why even Thomas, when was informed by the disciples that Jesus showed Himself to them during his absence, he had doubted, and he must see Jesus face to face, see for himself and touch His wounds for him to believe. Jesus showed Himself again on another occasion, now with Thomas present, to replace all doubts that he might have even just with a little faith. And Thomas exclaimed, "My Lord, and my God!"

Though the disciples' hearts were filled with fear and doubt, Jesus has found a little faith in them, He has still that big love for that little faith in their hearts and so he was sending them as the Father has sent Him. They have felt the faith of Jesus in them, that despite



their weaknesses and failure to understand His ways, He still has that unfailing love towards them. And, they had to be back to that track which they ought to take, that had to do what they were supposed to do, that is, to continue the mission of Jesus.

Love has the power to bring out the best to every person, love has the power to change a fearful heart to fearless proclaimer of Good News, love has the power to bring peace. That is the power of Christ's love for me and you for He has faith in us, he has that big love for the little faith that we have. In the same way, our faith to the little faith of our brothers and sisters and our big love to that little faith that they have can bring them back to our community, to our family, to our Church.



II Domingo de Pascua (Divina Misericordia)




Hoy es Domingo de la Misericordia; celebramos la gran misericordia de Dios al darnos a su Hijo para que nos salvara por medio de su vida, pasión, muerte y resurrección. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, en su numeral 1225, nos lo explica de la siguiente manera: "La sangre y el agua que brotaron del costado traspasado de Jesús crucificado (ver Juan 19:34) son figuras del Bautismo y de la Eucaristía, sacramento de vida nueva (ver 1 Juan 5:6-8): desde entonces, es posible 'nacer del agua y del Espíritu' para entrar en el Reino de Dios (ver

Juan 3:5). Con la Pasión, Muerte y Resurrección, se derramó su Misericordia. Por eso, hoy cantemos, llenos de alegría y esperanza, el Salmo 117: ¡La misericordia del Señor es eterna. ¡Aleluya!

Señor, para dar un sincero testimonio de tu resurrección, enséñame a ser dócil como Tú lo fuiste en tu vida terrena, y principalmente en la cruz. Encontrarnos y reconciliarnos es el mensaje que el Evangelio nos trae en este segundo Domingo de Pascua. Nos narra, también, la falta de fe de Tomás, de su incredulidad al recibir la noticia de que el Señor había resucitado. Tuvo que verlo y tocarlo para comprender toda la misericordia de Dios viva en Jesús: "Señor mío y Dios mío" (Juan 20:28). Y ahora, nosotros tenemos la dicha de creer sin ver. 


