We, the people of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Faith Community, baptized into Jesus Christ, formed by Word and Sacrament, and empowered by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, seek to be a visible sign of God's love. We seek to build the Kingdom of God by: Using our unique gifts to minister to one another, welcoming all and caring for those in need, teaching our faith to others and uniting in worship as a family with the Body of Christ.

My Dear People of God:

Going out from our comfort zones is something we do next to impossible. It is always a challenge to step out from what is comfortable, easy and where our expertise is. My spiritual director would always challenge me to do the things I wasn't comfortable with. He would usually ask, "Are you comfortable doing this thing?" And if I say "No" he would tell me, "Then do it." Going out beyond our comfort zones might be fearsome but it gives us the chance to grow, learn and develop things which we might have thought of to be impossible.

In our Gospel this Third Sunday of Easter, the disciples went back to what they have been doing before Jesus called them up to follow him, - fishing. Fishing was their expertise; it was what most comfortable with them, it was their life anyway. They had to go back to where they belong.

But spending all night fishing seemed to be fruitless, they caught nothing. They were experts in fishing, but they could not just do it in a painless way. In the midst of this disappointment, Jesus once again made His way into their lives. "Cast the nets into the right side of the boat and you will find something." (John 21:6) Lo and behold, they could hardly pull the net in because of the number of fish they have caught. It reminds us of how they've met Jesus in the same manner, "Put out into the deep and let your nets for a catch." (Luke 5:4) Both were invitation from Jesus to step out and do something else, something better. They must learn to give up what they've gotten used to do and have the courage to step up and move up in obedience to his invitation. It was their obedience to follow what Jesus was telling them that they caught more than what they have expected.

We are also being invited by Jesus to step out from our comfort zones do better things. We ought to grab the chance to "put out into the deep" and "cast



the nets into the other side" if we want to have that growth we've been longing for. It might be irksome and fearsome, but something has to be done. Obedience to what the Lord is asking us to do can bring out the best in us. This process might involve discomfort, but it is a key to a deeper and more intimate relationship with Him leading to have a confident faith in responding to Jesus' question to Peter, "Do you love me more than these?"

Hopefully, our response to the same question would lead us to a more meaningful and loving relationship with Jesus. Though it might require us step out from what is comfortable, it will surely lead us to where the grace of God abounds the more.

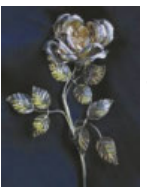

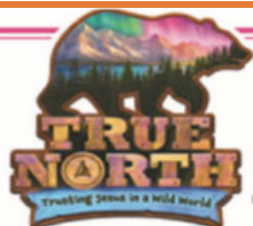

Anh chị em thân mến! Sau khi Phục Sinh, mặc dù Đức Giêsu đã hiện ra nhiều lần để chứng tỏ sự sống lại của Người, nhưng các Tông Đồ vẫn chưa vững niềm tin. Các ông tưởng mọi sự như đã chấm dứt với cái chết của Thầy mình, thế là họ trở về với nghề cũ, nghề đánh bắt cá. Các ông không còn nhớ tới lời mời gọi của Đức Giêsu thuở ban đầu: "Ta sẽ cho các người trở thành ngư phủ lưới người". Như thế, kế hoạch của Thiên Chúa nơi Đức Kitô xem ra như thất bại. Thế nhưng, với mẻ cá lạ hôm nay, Đấng Phục Sinh đã một lần nữa nhắc các Tông Đồ về nhiệm vụ: đánh lưới người về cho Thiên Chúa. Tuy nhiên để chu toàn được nhiệm vụ này, trước hết các ông phải là những người luôn lắng nghe và sống lời Chúa, để rồi nhờ sức mạnh của lời Chúa nâng đỡ, các ông đủ can đảm lên đường dẫn đưa mọi người về với Đấng Phục Sinh.



Đấng Phục sinh đang hiện diện giữa chúng ta. Có những lúc chúng ta không nhận ra Người, nhưng Người vẫn đồng hành với chúng ta, vì Người là Thiên Chúa quyền

năng và nhân ái. Khi cử hành phụng vụ mùa Phục sinh, Giáo Hội muốn cho chúng ta được gặp gỡ Đấng đã từ cõi chết sống lại. Chúa Phục Sinh cũng đang đặt ra cho mỗi người chúng ta câu hỏi về tình yêu mến: "Con có yêu mến Thầy không?". Câu trả lời của chúng ta thể hiện mức độ gắn thân theo Chúa và

thiện chí trở thành môn đệ của Người. Sau khi tuyên thệ một lòng yêu mến, Chúa Giêsu cũng sẽ nói với mỗi người chúng ta: "Hãy theo Thầy". Cuộc gặp gỡ với Đức Giêsu sẽ giúp chúng ta có thêm nghị lực và nhiệt huyết để làm chứng về Người, để nhân loại có thể nhận ra Người đang sống và đang hiện diện qua những môn đệ của Người là chính chúng ta.

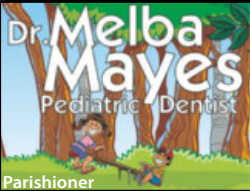

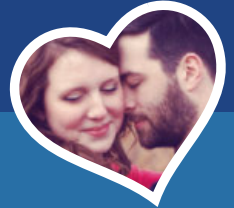
