Today we remember one of the greatest gifts of God to us, - our mother! Happy Mother's Day!


I read from a book mark: "If evolution is true, how come mothers still have only two hands?" We might have wished that mothers have more than two hands so that they can respond immediately all what we request them to do at home. That case, mothers should be superwoman!

One of the best biblical references when we talk about mothers is from Proverbs 31:1-31 which is a comprehensive description of a noble woman in a poetic manner highlighting her character and wisdom and summing it up towards the end is her distinguishing character, that is, her fear of the Lord, her life having Yahweh as the center of her life.

We know that as much as we want to have this ideal, a noble woman in our homes, a question still lingers in our minds, "Is this real or just too good to be true?" Some might have very endearing experiences with their mother, some just a normal thing and still others nothing special at all because the relationship might have strained for some reason. Looking at motherhood in the eyes of a mother however, gives us a different view. Being a mother is a gift but it is not always a bed of roses. As poet Wilhelm Busch once said: "To become a mother is not so difficult; on the other hand, being a mother is very much so!"

Writing a topic about motherhood at times is not easy. I was reminded once by a friend when I was asked to give a talk about mothers, he said: "Not all mothers deserve to be elevated to a special pedestal, place of honor or reverence, but a good number do."

Prominent people in history tell us how their life was greatly influenced by their mother as George Washington once said, "*All I am, I owe to my mother.*" Who are they really in our life? I want to share these light moments describing a real mother from the Sermon Notebook.




