#### PARISH MISSION STATEMENT


We, the people of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Faith Community, baptized into Jesus Christ, formed by Word and Sacrament, and empowered by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, seek to be a visible sign of God's love. We seek to build the Kingdom of God by: Using our unique gifts to minister to one another, welcoming all and caring for those in need, teaching our faith to others and uniting in worship as a family with the Body of Christ.

### Dear People of God:

In 2022, the National Eucharistic Revival was launched to emphasize the transforming power and mercy of Jesus in the Eucharist as the late Pope Francis described it as "a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ." As Catholics, we are supposed to be "healed, converted, formed and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist and who are then sent out on mission for the life of the world." (Vision of the National Eucharistic Revival) Although this is just a 3-year initiative, it was envisioned to continue throughout the Church especially in this Jubilee Year 2025 where we are asked to "be bearers of hope" in this world. Being bearers of hope is being always connected with the real source of our Christian life. As the Vatican II's document Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, Lumen Gentium has emphasized, "The Eucharistic sacrifice is the source and summit of the Christian life." (Chapter II, People of God)

Today as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ or commonly referred to as the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, we are reminded once again to be refreshed by the beauty of the real presence of Jesus in the form of bread and wine in the holy Eucharist. His words and actions in the last supper were not just symbolic but he intended the bread and wine to become his real body and blood, "This is my body... this is my blood." His words and actions in the last supper was a command to his disciples and to be reminded of his presence, "Do this in remembrance of me..." His words and actions in the last supper were meant for you and me to be always connected to where the source of grace is, "the source and summit of the Christian life."

St. Thomas Aquinas has initiated the concept of 'transubstantiation' to describe the transformation that occurs during the celebration of the holy Eucharist when the ordinary bread and wine become the actual body and blood of Jesus through the power of God and is mediated by the words of the priest in the consecration part of the Mass. This mystery of the Eucharist underlines our belief that what we do in the celebration is not just a symbolic act but real participation in Jesus' sacrifice, giving way for us to be connected to his divine presence.



St. Paul, in his first letter to the Corinthians, underscores the sacrificial nature of the celebration describing it as a participation in the body and blood of Christ. "The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a sharing in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a sharing in the body of Christ?" (1 Corinthians 10:16) St. Justin the Martyr in his writings also emphasized Jesus' real presence in the Eucharist and its importance in the life of the Church describing the Eucharist as the "flesh of our savior Jesus Christ."

Our active participation in the Eucharist should always be a participation in the wedding feast of the Lamb, a heavenly banquet with the real presence of Jesus. The document Gaudium Et Spes, On the Church in the Modern World reiterated that the Eucharist aid us towards holiness of life for "the Lord left behind a pledge of this hope and strength for life's rustic journey in that sacrament of faith where natural elements refined by man are gloriously changed into his body and blood, the providing a meal of brotherly solidarity and a foretaste of the heavenly banquet." (Chapter II)







Anh chị em thân mến! Hôm nay chúng ta cùng với Hội Thánh mừng kính trọng thể lễ Mình Máu Thánh Chúa Kitô. Thật ra, trong bất cứ Thánh Lễ nào, chúng ta cũng đã suy tôn mầu nhiệm Thánh Thể.

Tuy nhiên, vì muốn nhân mạnh tầm quan trọng của Thánh Thể trong đời sống của mỗi tín hữu, nên mẹ Hội Thánh đã chọn riêng một ngày để chúng ta dành thời giờ nhiều hơn trong việc tôn thờ, chiêm ngắm và tạ ơn tình yêu Thiên Chúa trong Bí tích Thánh Thể. Trong Bí Tích Thánh Thể, chúng ta được đón nhận chính Đức Giêsu là nguồn của mọi ân phúc. Nên giờ đây Chúa Giêsu

mời gọi chúng ta đến để tham dự bữa tiệc thánh trong Thánh lễ này, với lời tha thiết đầy yêu thương: "Tất cả các con hãy nhận lấy mà ăn, vì này là Mình Thầy. Tất cả các con hãy nhận lấy mà uống, vì này là Máu Thầy, các con hãy làm việc này mà nhớ đến Thầy". Trong Thánh lễ, sau khi linh mục chủ sự đọc

những lời của Chúa Giêsu, ngài tuyên bố: "Đây là mầu nhiệm đức tin". Quả thật, nếu quan sát Hình Bánh và Hình Rượu theo khía cạnh thể lý, sau lời "truyền phép": Đây là Mình Thày, đây là Máu Thày,


người ta chẳng thấy có gì thay đổi. Vẫn là tấm bánh ấy. Vẫn là chén rượu ấy. Việc cảm nhận Mình và Máu Thánh Chúa Giêsu là một hành vi của đức tin. Nói cách khác, chỉ có đức tin mới giúp chúng ta nhận ra sự hiện diện của Chúa Giêsu trong Bí tích Thánh Thể. Bài hát "Ca Thánh Thể – Tantum ergo" nêu rõ: "Ta hãy lấy đức tin bù lại, nếu giác

# MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

Como Jesús nos conoce, él sabía y sabe que nos gusta comer. Jesús, multiplica la comida; él sacia el hambre de aquella gente que lo buscaba por sus enseñanzas y por sus milagros. ¿Por qué buscas a Jesús? ¿Qué tipo de hambre sacia en tu vida? En el sacramento de la Eucaristía, Jesús nos dejó su presencia real para poder alimentarnos espiritualmente.

"El culto que se da a la Eucaristía fuera de la Misa es un valor inestimable en la vida de la Iglesia. Dicho culto está estrechamente unido a la celebración del sacrificio eucarístico. La presencia de Cristo bajo las sagradas especies que se conservan después de la Misa---presencia que dura mientras subsistan las especies del pan y del vino, deriva de la celebración del Sacrificio y tiende a la comunidad sacramental y espiritual. Corresponde a los Pastores animar, incluso con el testimonio personal, el culto eucarístico, particularmente la exposición del Santísimo sacramento y la adoración de Cristo presente bajo las especies eucarísticas.
