My Dear People of God:

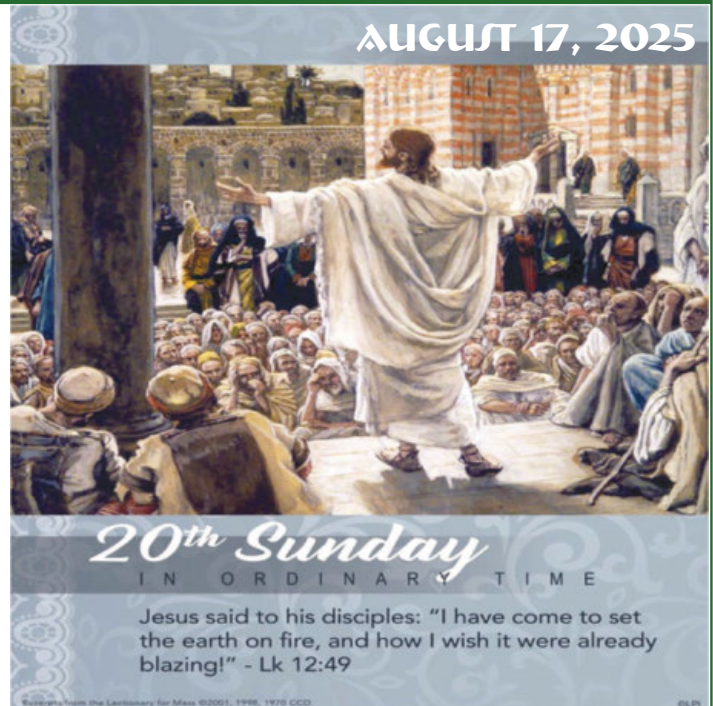
There is this quote from the Wilder Poetry, "*Don't play with fire if you can't handle the flame.*" It is always a reminder to be careful about our human tendency to flirt with situations that can lead us to danger. At times, acting recklessly causes harm to someone and even on our self.

Fire in the Scriptures has been used in several instances, both with negative and positive presentations. Fire through the burning bush has brought to Moses a mission to lead the Israelites from Egypt to the Promised Land (Exodus 3:2), fire has guided the Israelites in their journey throughout the desert (Exodus 13:21), the Holy Spirit descended to the apostles as tongues of fire during Pentecost (Acts 2:3). In the Book of Daniel, those who will not worship the golden image will be thrown into the fiery furnace (3:8). The Gospel of Matthew, trees that do not bear good fruits shall be cut down and thrown into the fire (7:19), the wicked shall also be thrown into the fire where they grind their teeth (13:22). And in our Gospel this 20<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus was talking about fire, he said, "*I have come to set the earth on fire and how I wish it were already blazing!*" (Luke 12:49)

Fire carried a lot of symbolism in the Scriptures but whether it was presented in a negative or positive way, one thing is for sure, fire always leads to change!

Since the fall in the Book of Genesis, change has always been the standard message of the prophets, it was their battle cry throughout the Old Testament and when John the Baptist came, and his message was the same, crying out in the wilderness inviting us for repentance, for a change.

Change is something that many people are not ready to embrace. It is a struggle that many of us would try as much as we can to escape, no matter how difficult it takes. Change can also lead to a struggle within us, especially if it involves shedding out our security blankets, giving up something that in our personal judgement is important and taking that "leap of faith" that can transform our lives or the lives of others around us. There are also changes that can create animosity



among us and Jesus has pointed this out. "*Do you think that I have come to establish peace on earth? No, I tell you, but rather division.*" (Luke 12:51)

But yes, Jesus wants to bring peace on earth that is why in many instances after his resurrection, he would show himself to his disciples with the greeting of peace, but not just the peace that we usually know like the absence of war or when we agree with one another. Jesus wants a genuine peace that brings a change of heart, a peace that makes us choose between right and wrong, between love and hate, between good and bad. This is the peace that burns our selfish desires and molds us once again into the image of God.

This is where Jesus wants us to lead into, having that fire that changes us, a fire that ignites our willingness to say as the Psalmist does, "*Create a clean heart in me O God, and renew in me a steadfast spirit!*" (Psalm 51:10). And there lies the genuine peace that Jesus brings.

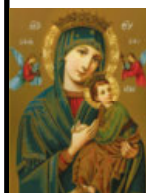

Anh chị em thân mến! “Thầy đến để đem lửa xuống thế gian”. Lửa đây chính là sứ mạng cứu độ của Chúa, là ngọn lửa tình yêu mà Người muốn dùng để thanh tẩy, đốt nóng và làm cho bùng cháy lên ơn cứu độ của Người. Và Người khắc khoải biết bao để “lửa ấy vẫn cháy mãi lên” thiêu hủy những căn cỗi, thanh lọc những ô nhơ, làm ấm lại cõi lòng băng giá và soi sáng con người trên bước đường tìm kiếm sự thật. Chúa muốn ngọn lửa tình yêu mà Người đã từng đem đến trần gian mãi mãi được thắp sáng lên trong tâm hồn mỗi người chúng ta. Người yêu thương ta như đối tượng của tình yêu Người, mặc dù chúng ta vô ơn, bội phản hay quay lưng lại với tình yêu đó. Người kêu gọi từng người chúng ta hãy tiếp nối sứ mạng đem lửa thắp sáng khắp thế giới, bằng chính cuộc sống chứng nhân của mỗi người trong mọi hoàn cảnh. Đức Giêsu đã dùng hình ảnh lửa và gươm để diễn tả những gian



nan thử thách mà những ai tin vào Người sẽ phải trải qua. Khi nói đến lửa và gươm là người ta nghĩ đến chiến tranh, bạo lực, chia rẽ và xung đột. Những ai tin vào Đức Giêsu, phải dành cho Người một mối tình chung thủy và ưu tiên, đôi khi phải vượt lên những mối liên hệ huyết thống thiêng liêng. Trong thực tế, một số anh chị em trưởng thành xin gia nhập Đạo gặp chống đối gay gắt từ phía gia đình, anh chị em, vì những người này có thành kiến với Giáo Hội Công giáo. Có những người can đảm chấp nhận những mâu thuẫn để theo Đức Giêsu. Lửa và lưỡi gươm đang đi ngang qua cuộc đời của họ. Tuy vậy, với thời gian, lòng đạo đức và thiện chí tuân theo giáo huấn của Chúa Giêsu sẽ thuyết phục những người còn nghi ngại, và hoà bình đã trở lại. Niềm vui đang đầy khi việc theo Chúa Giêsu không còn là một mối nghi kỵ.

## MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

La forma como nos llevamos a veces en la familia y con los amigos es dolorosa: pleitos, venganzas, argumentos sin sentido, tan solo para herirnos. Alegamos por política, por deporte, por religión y más. Nos encendemos de la nada; pareciera que traemos fuego para discutir. Perdemos el control de la nada y por nada. Pero el fuego del que Jesús nos habla hoy es diferente. Es el fuego de la justicia, del perdón y de la inclusión: “He venido a traer fuego a la tierra, y ¡cuánto desearía que ya estuviera ardiendo!” (Lucas 12:49). Compartir esa pasión por Jesús es algo que muy pocos entienden. Se trata del fuego del Espíritu Santo en nosotros.

De nuevo se nos repite la misión de Jesús al mundo: “Traer a la tierra el fuego que enciende la vida y mediante el cual el hombre es salvado. Jesús nos llama a difundir en el mundo este fuego, gracias al cual seremos reconocidos como sus verdaderos discípulos” (Papa Francisco). San Juan Crisóstomo (c. 350-407) decía que: “Esto es el fuego del Espíritu Santo: él no tolera que se tenga algún deseo mundano; en cuanto, nos conduce a otro tipo de amor... De hecho,



cuando la fuerza de este fuego ha entrado en el alma del hombre, éste expulsa la indiferencia y la pereza.” Dejarnos conducir por el Espíritu Santo es el secreto que nos dispone a dar la cara por la justicia y la paz. De esas divisiones habla Jesús, referente a estar en contra unos de otros en la familia y los amigos. Es que vivir el Evangelio y ser testigos de él dando testimonio divide.
