
My Dear People of God:

On this Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord, the Universal Church also officially closes the Jubilee of Hope 2025, having the theme, "Pilgrims of Hope." Throughout the year, we were asked to be bearers of hope in the world, that no matter how difficult life maybe and even amid uncertainties, 'hope does not disappoint' (Romans 5:5), and even if the Jubilee of Hope closes, our journey as pilgrims of hope still continues.

On this Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord, Christ Jesus revealed himself to the Gentiles represented by the Magi who were on their long journey yet, bearing in their hearts the flame of hope that soon they would find what they were seeking for. Their journey is the same spiritual journey that we have, for our life here on earth is first, a pilgrimage of hope, second, a pilgrimage of seeking the truth and third, a pilgrimage that leads to transformation.

The Epiphany story started as a pilgrimage of hope. The wise men from the East have set out on a long journey filled with uncertainties, having only a star as their guide. That journey was a quest for truth not for comfort or security. It was a pilgrimage that mirrors our spiritual pilgrimage – a journey of faith that at times requires us to leave our comfort zones and stepping out into uncertainties but bearing in our hearts the burning hope that God gives. Each step, no matter how little or big it maybe, brings us closer to a deeper understanding of our faith. But it is not just reaching our destination that matters but the process of being formed along the journey as we walk with the zeal of hope.

It is also pilgrimage of seeking the truth. The wise men were persistent seekers not just about new discoveries or new meanings of the movements of the stars, but seekers of the truth. They have the desire to find the truth more than what the



world could offer. They followed the signs as they listened to their hearts. This is also our journey of faith, we are searching for the truth, for God, for the Word made flesh. We must have the hunger and thirst for that truth, "for truth will set you free." (John 8:32)

Lastly, it is a pilgrimage that leads to transformation. When the wise men met the infant Jesus, it was an encounter not of wonder but of profound transformation. When they returned home, they changed their route, signifying that genuine encounter with God leads to change. Our pilgrimage should always lead us to transformation starting from within. We don't return to the same old ways when we encounter the Lord, - our values, relationships, and beliefs are renewed.

The Feast of Epiphany of the Lord then, invites us to continue journeying with hope, seek the truth that frees us and embrace a genuine transformation after our encounter with Christ.





Anh chị em thân mến, Lễ Hiển Linh cử hành biến cố ba nhà đạo sĩ đến thờ lạy Chúa. Họ là ba người ngoài Do Thái, được coi là dân ngoại nhưng đã tìm hiểu và tin nhận Chúa Giê-su là Chúa của mình. Vì thế ngày lễ này được coi là ngày lễ của niềm tin. Chiêm ngắm cuộc hành trình đức tin của ba nhà đạo sĩ, chúng ta có dịp để hâm nóng lại niềm tin của mình.

Tất cả chúng ta đây là các đạo sĩ của thời nay, có nhiệm vụ làm cho cả thế giới nhận biết Chúa Giê-su là Đáng Cứu Chuộc nhân loại. Lời ngôn sứ I-sai-a thôii thúc chúng ta: “Hãy đứng lên, hãy tỏa sáng ra, hỡi Giê-ru-sa-lem! Vì sự sáng của ngươi đã tới, vì vinh quang của Chúa đã bừng dậy trên mình ngươi. 


