## PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

We, the people of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Faith Community, baptized into Jesus Christ, formed by Word and Sacrament, and empowered by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, seek to be a visible sign of God's love. We seek to build the Kingdom of God by: Using our unique gifts to minister to one another, welcoming all and caring for those in need, teaching our faith to others and uniting in worship as a family with the Body of Christ.

My Dear People of God:

Do you remember the date of your Baptism? The late Pope Francis has repeatedly asked us Catholics to always remember the day of our Baptism and to celebrate it at least as much as we celebrate our birthday or married couples celebrate their wedding anniversary. He said that this might even be more important than our birth date for this is our rebirth as sons and daughters of God, we become heirs of the Kingdom.

Today, as we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, we are drawn into the profound mystery of Jesus' public revelation at the River Jordan inaugurating his public ministry. Our readings invite us to reflect both the humility of Christ and the fulfillment of God's promise for a servant who brings newness of life to the nations.

In the Gospel, we witness Jesus approaching John the Baptist at the Jordan River and recognizing Jesus' holiness, John protests: "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?" (Mt 3:14). Yet Jesus insists, "Let it be so now; for it is proper for us in this way to fulfill all righteousness" (Mt 3:15). Jesus' humble act was a step dipping into the waters of repentance not for himself but for our own sake, identifying fully with our human sinfulness. This was an act which opens for us the path to new life and forgiveness.

Baptism is a public proclamation of faith and intention to live a life that follows the ways of God. In many Catholic churches, we find holy water fonts at the entrance so that as we enter the Church, we first recall the saving waters of baptism, that waters that made us sons and daughters of God. When we do the sign of the cross with the holy water, we renew our baptismal promises, we vow anew to resist evil, to love our neighbors as ourselves, to strive to live the holiness of life, to respect the dignity of every human person and to embrace the fullness of life in God.

As we emerge from that experience of renewing our baptismal promises, the Father's voice echoes once again: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased" (Mt 3:17). As this was a remarkable scene affirming Jesus' identity, it also reveals the redeeming love of God that flows into the world. As the Holy Spirit rests upon him and embarks on his mission, the Holy Spirit dwells in us making us temples that bears the holiness of God, empowering us to live lives pleasing to the Father, becoming signs of hope in a troubled world.

We celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord every year hoping that it will make us think again of our own baptism, reignite the flame of holiness in us and leads us to embark on a new journey of faith.

Take a moment now on this feast to reflect where our baptismal journey has brought us into.

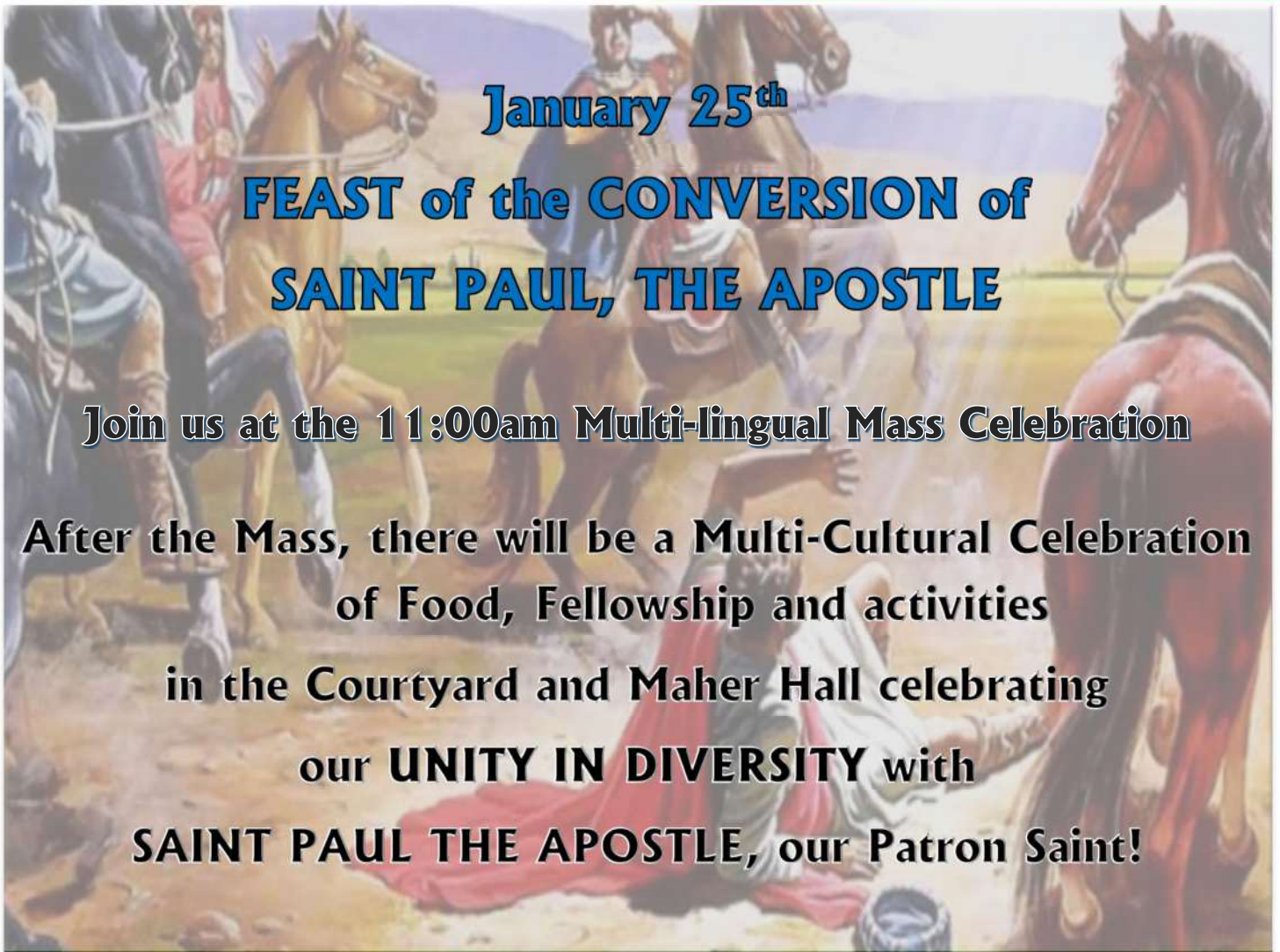

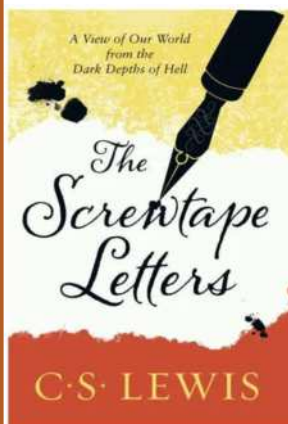

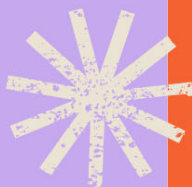

Tại sao Chúa Giêsu là Thiên Chúa, Đấng vô tội, lại lãnh nhận phép Rửa của ông Gioan? Chúng ta thường đặt ra câu hỏi ấy. Việc Chúa lãnh nhận phép Rửa không phải vì Chúa mang tội, nhưng thể hiện sự khiêm tốn hạ mình, như Thánh Phaolô viết: “Đức Giêsu Kitô vốn dĩ là Thiên Chúa, mà không nghĩ phải nhất quyết duy trì địa vị ngang hàng với Thiên Chúa, nhưng đã hoàn toàn trút bỏ vinh quang mặc lấy thân nô lệ, trở nên giống phàm nhân, sống như người trần thế” (Pl 2,6-7). Đức Giêsu hoà mình vào dòng người đang bị lên án gay gắt là những tội nhân và cúi mình xin được nhận lãnh phép rửa. Chính ông Gioan cũng ngạc nhiên và do dự khi thấy Người đến với ông. Trước sự chần chừ của ông Gioan, Chúa Giêsu nói: “Chúng ta làm như vậy để giữ trọn đức công chính” (Mt 3,15). Khi bước xuống dòng sông Giordan, Chúa Giêsu muốn chứng minh:



Người muốn liên đới với con người tội lỗi. Sau này, Chúa khẳng định: “Tôi không đến vì người mạnh khỏe, nhưng vì những người đau yếu”. Qua việc lãnh nhận phép rửa, Chúa cũng cho thấy ước vọng của Người là cứu chữa hết mọi người, kể cả những tội nhân, và khẳng định với họ: mọi người đều có quyền hy vọng vào lòng thương xót của Thiên Chúa, vì Ngài là Cha yêu thương.

“Con là Con yêu dấu của Cha, Con đẹp lòng Cha”. Hôm nay, Chúa Cha đang nói với mỗi người chúng ta như vậy, bởi nhờ Chúa Giêsu và trong Chúa Giêsu,

chúng ta được trở nên những người con yêu dấu của Ngài. Nhờ tình yêu của Chúa cư ngụ trong chúng ta, chúng ta có thể trở nên chứng nhân của Chúa và chứng nhân về niềm hy vọng nơi cuộc sống vĩnh cửu.

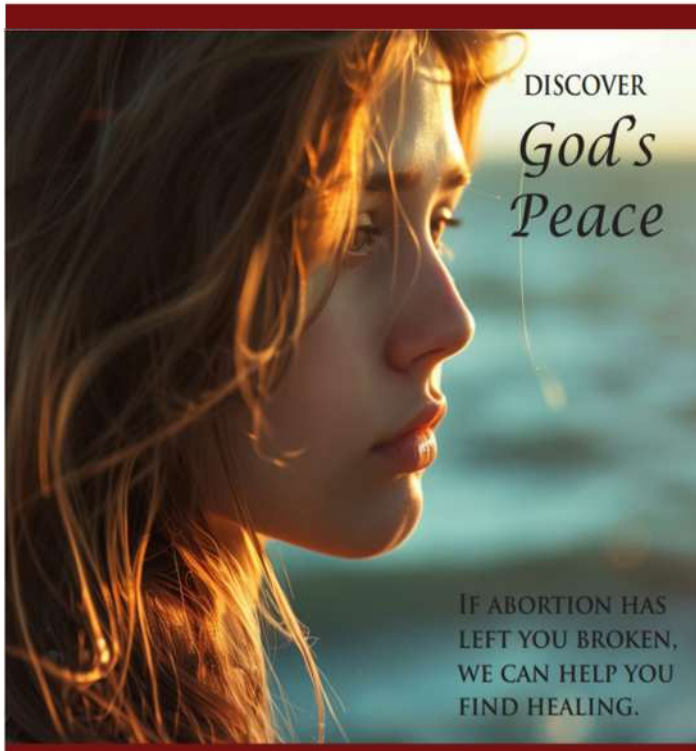
