We, the people of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Faith Community, baptized into Jesus Christ, formed by Word and Sacrament, and empowered by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, seek to be a visible sign of God's love. We seek to build the Kingdom of God by: Using our unique gifts to minister to one another, welcoming all and caring for those in need, teaching our faith to others and uniting in worship as a family with the Body of Christ.

My Dear People of God

We have entered into another season of our liturgical calendar, the Ordinary Time. It spans from the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord last Sunday to Tuesday, February 17, for the next day, February 18 is Ash Wednesday which signals the beginning of another liturgical season, that is, Lent.

Ordinary Time leads us deeper into reflection about the "Word made Flesh," the reality of the Emmanuel, God-with-us. This season invites us to dive more deeply into the reality of Jesus penetrating into our human history, transforming it to salvation history. It is a season for growth and maturity in our faith, guided by the ministry of teaching and healing of Jesus.

Today, we turn our attention to John the Baptist announcing Jesus as the Lamb of God, "Look, the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world!" John says recognizing Jesus as someone sent from heaven, the Chosen One, the Son of God.

John the Baptist recognized Jesus as the Lamb of God. In ancient Israel, lambs were used as sacrifices to atone for sin which is the heart of their worship, and when John says Jesus as the Lamb of God, he is indicating that Jesus goes for a mission, that is, the sacrifice given by God to redeem the world. God's plan is in Jesus for the redemption of humankind.

In the First reading from the Book of the Prophet Isaiah, we hear the voice of God's servant proclaiming not only the restoration of God's people but will also bring that light to the nations. "It is to light a thing that you should by my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob," he declares but this proclamation extends to the ends of the earth. It is underlining the

universality of the mission and work of Christ, that redemption is meant for all.

John the Baptist and the Prophet Isaiah both expressed the universality of God's plan of salvation. Jesus fulfills this plan as the Lamb offered for sacrifice, no longer at the altar in the temple but at the cross in Calvary. He is the light that shines through the corners of the earth.

We are called then, to be witnesses and testify to the world about this changing love of God in Jesus. Like John the Baptist pointing out to Jesus, we are invited to always point to Jesus, seeing and sharing the Lamb of God who brings hope and new life to all. And like the Prophet Isaiah, we are challenged to carry the light and bring the light to all




ONELIFELA WALK FOR LIFE

Chúa Giêsu là Chúa của muôn người. Thánh Phaolô đã khẳng định điều này trong thư gửi giáo dân Corintô (Bài đọc II). Những ai tin vào Người sẽ được hiến thánh nhờ bí tích Thanh Tẩy. Đây là huyền nhiệm của tình thương, do quyền năng của Thiên Chúa, Đáng yêu thương con người và muốn cho mọi người được cứu rỗi. Như thế, người tín hữu được vinh dự lớn lao nhờ tin vào Chúa Giêsu. Được trở nên đồng hình đồng dạng với Đức Giêsu trong bí tích Thanh Tẩy, người tín hữu cũng trở nên những "người được Chúa Cha tuyển chọn". Ông gọi và bỗn phận của người tín hữu là giới thiệu Chúa Giêsu với mọi người, đồng thời làm phản ánh hình ảnh của Người qua chính cuộc đời thánh thiện công chính của mình, để rồi trong lời nói, tư tưởng cũng như việc làm, đều làm cho hình ảnh của Đức Giêsu hiển hiện. Đó cũng là sứ mạng làm chứng cho Chúa trong cuộc sống hôm nay. Chúa Giêsu là Đáng được Thiên Chúa tuyển



chọn. Đây là lời chứng của ông Gioan Tẩy Giả. Đây cũng là lời chứng của ngôn sứ Isaia. Khái niệm "Đáng được Thiên Chúa tuyển chọn" cũng giống như "Đáng được Thiên Chúa sai đi", hay "Đáng Thiên sai". Trong Tin Mừng, nhiều lần Đức Giêsu khẳng định Người được Chúa Cha sai đến trần gian. Việc tuyển này được chính Chúa Cha xác nhận, khi Đức Giêsu được ông Gioan thanh tẩy trong dòng sông Giordan. Việc Chúa Cha sai Con của Ngài đến trần gian là bằng chứng tình yêu của Thiên Chúa đối với nhân loại, như lời Chúa Giêsu nói với ông Nicôđêmô: "Thiên Chúa yêu thế gian, đến nỗi đã ban Con Một, để ai tin vào Con của Người thì khỏi phải chết, nhưng được sống muôn đời" (Ga 3,16). Như thế, sứ mạng của Chúa Giêsu là đến trần gian để quảng diễn tình yêu của Chúa Cha, đồng thời mời gọi mọi người nhận ra tình yêu ấy để sống tốt, đền đáp tình yêu thương của Chúa Cha.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

Iniciamos hoy el Tiempo Ordinario. Tendremos cinco domingos en los que los textos del evangelio nos presentarán la imagen de Jesús en su vida pública. Sus milagros, sus curaciones y sus enseñanzas, sin duda, nos invitarán a un cambio radical del corazón. Eso es precisamente lo que se busca: que sigamos el ejemplo de Juan Bautista, el primer testigo de Jesús, quien hoy nos lo presenta como el "Cordero de Dios." Juan deja claro que él no es el Mesías esperado. Quiere que reconozcamos a Jesús como la luz que existía desde siempre: "Ahí viene el Cordero de Dios, el que quita el pecado del mundo" (Juan 1:29). Jesús quita el pecado del mundo, pero es necesario trabajar con esfuerzo para que esto se haga realidad: trabajar por la justicia y por la paz, comenzando por uno mismo.

El Papa León XIV, desde su pontificado, nos llama a buscar la justicia y la paz, y nos dice: "Es la hora del amor. Fui elegido sin ningún mérito y, con temor y temblor, vengo a ustedes como un hermano que desea hacerse siervo de la fe y de la alegría, caminando con ustedes por

el camino del amor de Dios, que nos quiere a todos unidos en una única familia" (Domingo 18 de mayo de 2025). Animados con esta confianza, seamos testigos de fe y alegría, anunciando al mundo la Buena Noticia del Señor Jesús. Con estos dos ejemplos de vida, Juan Bautista y el Papa León XIV, demos la batalla por alcanzar un mundo donde reinen la paz y la esperanza como bautizados debe ser el mismo:


