PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

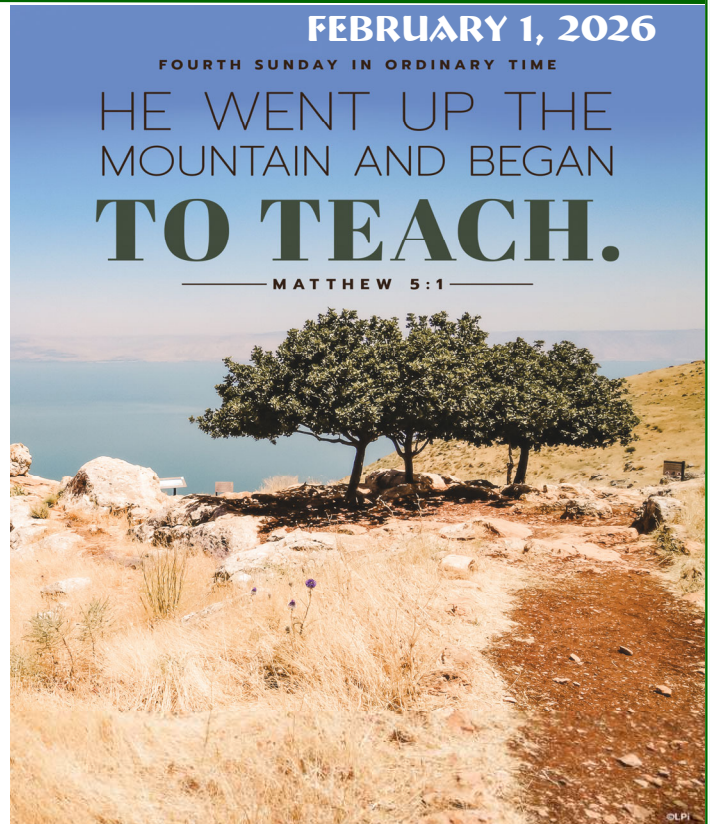
We, the people of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Faith Community, baptized into Jesus Christ, formed by Word and Sacrament, and empowered by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, seek to be a visible sign of God's love. We seek to build the Kingdom of God by: Using our unique gifts to minister to one another, welcoming all and caring for those in need, teaching our faith to others and uniting in worship as a family with the Body of Christ.

My Dear People of God

The Beatitudes in our Gospel today from Matthew invites to step into one of the most profound teachings Jesus ever offered, always challenging us in our faith life journey. The Beatitudes serve as an introduction to His Sermon on the Mount speaking directly to our hearts that yearn for meaning, hope, and a deeper relationship with God.

The word "blessed" is repeated several times as a reminder that contrary to what we usually believed in which blessing meant prosperity, comfort, or social standing, Jesus' blessings are not reserved for the powerful or people who are known, but for those who, according to our own human perspective are least: the poor in spirit, those who mourn, the meek, the hungry, the merciful, the pure, the peacemakers, and the persecuted.

This is a radical change of perspective. We are invited to strive for a way of living that draws strength directly from God's grace instead of social status or security or even material wealth. He assures us that God is closest to those who find themselves lacking, grieving, or yearning for justice for the sake of the Kingdom. The Beatitude describes an attitude that allows the Kingdom of God to break into our lives and slowly molding us according to his ways. The poor in spirit is a recognition of our deepest need of God, those who carry the heaviness of broken life finds comfort in God, those who know how to choose gentleness over force find the inheritance from God, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness will have divine satisfaction, those with sincere hearts will come face to face with God. This is how the Kingdom of God works and it invites us to honestly look deep into our hearts: what do I value in my life – power, pride, possession? Or do I work quietly for the virtues of God's Kingdom?



The values that the Beatitudes want us to live out can be transmitted to what we can do in our parish community. This weekend, we start to share again our blessings to the needy by helping and supporting our Diocesan Development Fund (DDF). Last year, we were able to surpass the goal which the Diocese has set, we received more than what we have expected and so the over-goal will be given back to our parish to support our programs and activities that deepen our mission in response to the Gospel invitation. We dare to follow Christ, even when the path is difficult. We do our best to embrace the blessings Jesus speaks in the Beatitudes, and may we, in turn, become a blessing to our community, embodying the love, generosity, and peace of Christ to one another.

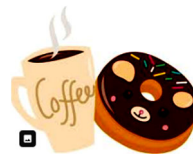

EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT FIRST FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 6TH

Many have asked what to do during Eucharistic Adoration. The following is a suggestion that you might want to follow. Don't forget your Bible.

Divide the Holy Hour into four 15 minute segments.

The first 15 minutes ponder on Jesus in the Eucharist. Read John 6: 22-71 and meditate on the miracle of Holy Communion.

The second 15 minutes praise Him and thank Him for all He has done for you. Read Psalm 66

The third 15 minutes focus on petition and ask God for all your needs. Read and meditate on Psalm 91.

The last 15 minutes focus on reparation for your sins. Read Psalm 51

Join in for Eucharistic Adoration on First Friday, February 6th after the 8:00 a.m. Mass until 6:45 p.m.

Remember the Chapel is always open **Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday (except First Friday)** from **8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** for Adoration with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from **5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.**

Adoration with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is held in the **Church on Tuesdays** starting at **8:30 a.m.** and concluding with the Reposition of the Blessed Sacrament at **6:45 p.m.**

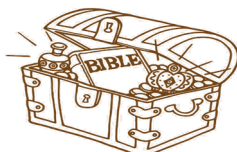

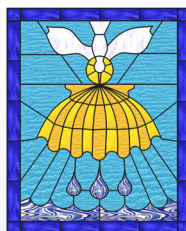

Bài Tin Mừng Chúa nhật thứ bốn thường niên thường được gọi là “Tám mối phúc thật”. Đây là phần mở đầu của “Bài giảng trên núi”, theo Tin Mừng thánh Matthêu. Có thể nói, bài giảng này tóm lược những nét chính trong toàn bộ giáo huấn của Chúa Giêsu. Bài giảng này cũng phác họa chân dung của Chúa, như mẫu mực để mọi tín hữu noi theo, nhờ đó mà đạt được hạnh phúc vĩnh cửu. Đức Giêsu không chỉ giảng dạy bằng những công thức hoặc lý thuyết, nhưng bằng chính cuộc đời của Người. Tám mối phúc cũng là tám nét diễn tả cuộc đời và sứ mạng của Chúa: Chúa trở nên khó nghèo cho chúng ta được giàu sang; Chúa hiền lành và khiêm nhường trong lòng; Chúa rơi lệ trước nỗi thống khổ của nhân gian; Chúa khao khát sự công chính cho loài người; Chúa là Đấng diễn tả lòng thương xót của Chúa Cha; Chúa là Đấng có trái tim trong sạch; Chúa đến để thiết lập vương quốc hoà bình;



Chúa bị bách hại và chấp nhận khổ hình thập giá để làm chứng cho Chân lý. Những mối phúc này cũng phác họa chân dung của người môn đệ đích thực. Không ai có thể mang danh Đức Kitô (Kitô hữu), mà lại khước từ những đề nghị của Người. Chấp nhận làm môn đệ Đức Giêsu, đôi khi bị coi là điên dại dưới cái nhìn của người trần thế. Thánh Phaolô đã quảng diễn cho chúng ta thấy, sự “điên dại” của Thiên Chúa, đúng hơn là sự điên dại theo cái nhìn của loài người, lại khôn ngoan gấp trăm lần sự khôn ngoan theo lẽ thế gian. Quả vậy, thập giá đối với người Do Thái là sự hèn hạ, đáng khinh bỉ, nhưng đối với các Kitô hữu thì đó lại là trường dạy sự khôn ngoan và là niềm tự hào. Chính Chúa Kitô là sự Khôn Ngoan của Thiên Chúa. Ai trung tín theo Người thì sẽ trở nên những người khôn ngoan. Bởi lẽ trong Người mà chúng ta được vinh quang. Người là niềm tự hào của chúng ta.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

Las lecturas de este domingo son tan fuertes en cuanto a la pobreza y la humildad, que parecen no concordar con la sociedad actual. Existen ciertas realidades en el mundo donde los pobres, los humildes y los inmigrantes no tienen cabida en los planes de los ricos y poderosos. Sin embargo, para consuelo ante esta situación, esto ya ocurría en tiempos del profeta Sofonías. Fijémonos en sus palabras: *“Busquen al Señor ustedes, todos los humildes de la tierra, los que cumplen sus preceptos; practiquen la justicia y busquen la humildad; tal vez esto los proteja el día de la ira del Señor”* (Sofonías 2:3). Son los pobres y los sencillos quienes siempre están buscando y confiando en Dios. Optar por la pobreza es un verdadero don del Espíritu Santo, que implica servir y trabajar por el Reino de Dios. La pobreza de espíritu debe penetrar el mundo con la ternura y la misericordia de Dios. Cada bautizado debe asumir la responsabilidad de hacer que esto suceda.

Las bienaventuranzas proclamadas por Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy son una enseñanza clave para la vida diaria. Al escuchar su Palabra, nos

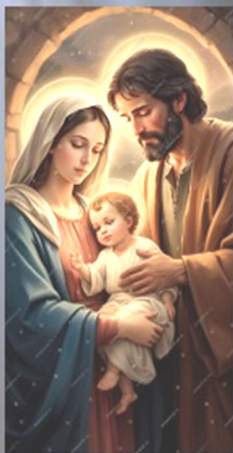
