We, the people of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Faith Community, baptized into Jesus Christ, formed by Word and Sacrament, and empowered by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, seek to be a visible sign of God's love. We seek to build the Kingdom of God by: Using our unique gifts to minister to one another, welcoming all and caring for those in need, teaching our faith to others and uniting in worship as a family with the Body of Christ.

My Dear People of God:

Last week, Jesus began his Sermon on the Mount by inviting and challenging us through the beatitudes. We were reminded of being blessed if we live the ways of God as opposed to what the world can offer us. This Sunday, Jesus continues to deepen his sermon by telling us: "You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? ... You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden." (Matthew 5:13-16)

Salt is used to preserve food, bring flavor and taste, and in the time of Jesus, it symbolizes purity. As he invites us to be the salt of the earth, he calls us to preserve the divine virtues and values in this world where there are so much negativity and indifference. Salt might have an unnoticeable presence, but its absence is undeniable. The same is true with the effect of our life patterned after the teachings of Jesus. At times, we might seem to be insignificant, but our absence can have an impact in the lives of people. However, if we become complacent and lose our values and virtues, like the salt, our presence becomes meaningless and we can lose as well the essence of our identity as Christians.

Jesus also invites us to be the light of the world. We are meant to shine amid darkness; we are meant to bear the light of Christ and bring them to others, we, who hear the Word of God are supposed to illuminate the path for our brothers and sisters who are in search for truth, direction and the meaning and purpose of life. He reminds us not to "light a lamp and then put it under the bushel basket; it is set on a lamp-stand, where it gives light to all in the house." Our identity as followers of Jesus,

having those Christian virtues and values, must continue to shine in this world. We should always be a visible sign of God's presence among peoples and so living witnesses of His love and mercy in a world that at times marred with unfaithfulness and selfishness. We are challenged to stand out and be an instrument of God's goodness and grace.

Each day is an invitation for us to be the salt of the earth and light of the world, making a difference no matter how big or small it may be, - a word of encouragement, an act of kindness, a refusal to join in any form of gossip, a small act of generosity, a tap on the shoulder of a person who is in trouble, a sweet smile to someone who is having a bad day — these are the grains of salt and rays of light that can transform our world and make it a better place to live in.

BLESSED PALMS NEEDED!!

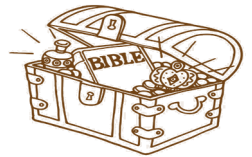

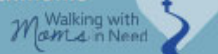

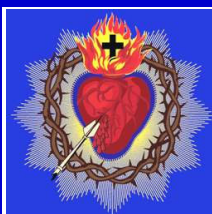

Sống trên đời, mỗi người chúng ta giống như một ngôi sao trên bầu trời. Triệu triệu ngôi sao trong dải ngân hà, không có hai ngôi sao giống nhau hoàn toàn. Những ngôi sao khác nhau về kích cỡ, về cường độ ánh sáng và về tốc độ vận chuyển. Thiên Chúa là Đấng “ấn định con số các vì sao, và đặt tên cho từng ngôi một” (Tv 147,4). Thiên Chúa cũng biết mỗi người chúng ta, và Ngài khắc tên chúng ta trong bàn tay của Ngài. “Ta đã gọi con bằng chính tên con. Con là của riêng Ta” (Is 43,1).

Chúa Giêsu mời gọi những ai muốn theo Chúa phải toả sáng như những ngôi sao trên bầu trời. Sống trên đời, mỗi người một tên gọi, một khuôn mặt, một cá tính, một nghề nghiệp và một sở thích. Tuy vậy, lý tưởng chung của tất cả đều là sự hoàn thiện, mặc dù khái niệm “hoàn thiện” được hiểu khác nhau.



Toả sáng giữa đời, đó là sứ mạng của mỗi chúng ta. “Chính anh em là ánh sáng cho trần gian”. Đây vừa là lời mời gọi, vừa là một mệnh lệnh mà Chúa Giêsu đưa ra cho các môn đệ. Chúa Kitô là ánh sáng thế gian. Những ai đi theo Người cũng phải trở

nên ánh sáng, vì tin vào Chúa là cố gắng nỗ lực mỗi ngày để trở nên giống như Người. Lệnh truyền này không phải là lý thuyết, nhưng là những việc thiện hảo mà người môn đệ thực hiện đối với những người xung quanh. Những việc tốt lành này sẽ giúp người tín hữu toả sáng giữa đời. Những người chưa tin Chúa sẽ nhận ra Người thông qua những cử chỉ tốt lành mà người môn đệ đang làm. Thánh Phaolô khuyên chúng ta hãy cậy dựa vào lẽ khôn ngoan của Thiên Chúa, chứ đừng dựa vào người phàm. Nhờ đó, chúng ta có đức tin chân thật và vững chắc.

Hoy la liturgia nos prepara, con su Palabra, a ser conscientes de lo que significa ser sal y luz en nuestra vida cotidiana. Jesús pone como ejemplo elementos que usamos todos los días para dar sabor a la vida del cristiano. La amargura, la envidia y la oscuridad de pensamientos nos alejan de lo que verdaderamente importa: ser sencillos y encontrarnos con Dios. *“Ustedes son la sal de la tierra. Pero si la sal se vuelve insípida, ¿cómo podrá ser salada de nuevo? Ya no sirve para nada, por lo que se tira afuera y es pisoteada por la gente”* (Mateo 5:13). Darle saborcito a la vida, añadiendo colores de humildad y apertura al diálogo frente a las adversidades que vivimos en la familia y en la sociedad, será clave para purificar y transformar nuestro entorno.

El Señor también nos llama luz del mundo: *“Nadie enciende una lámpara para taparla con un cajón; la ponen más bien sobre un candelero, y alumbra a todos los que están en la casa”* (Mateo 5:14-15). Cuando se va la luz en nuestra casa, nos sorprende, porque a veces no tenemos ni siquiera una vela que nos

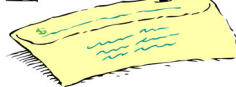
