We, the people of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Faith Community, baptized into Jesus Christ, formed by Word and Sacrament, and empowered by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, seek to be a visible sign of God's love. We seek to build the Kingdom of God by: Using our unique gifts to minister to one another, welcoming all and caring for those in need, teaching our faith to others and uniting in worship as a family with the Body of Christ.

My Dear People of God:

Today is the First Sunday of Lent which is an invitation to step into the wilderness following the journey of Jesus who was led by the Holy Spirit into the desert for forty days, — days in which we are challenged to go about transformation, reparation and renewal of life.

The Gospel recounts how Jesus spent forty days of solitude, challenge, and test in the wilderness. The desert experience of Jesus is a way for us to face and embrace the same experience in which we are confronted with temptation, hunger and loneliness. It is an experience that exposes our limitations and weaknesses but also leads us to a realization about God meeting us in the wilderness. This season of Lent challenges us to step away from what is familiar and let God speak to us deeply in our hearts.

Lent is a time to reflect more deeply, to repent more truthfully, and to reconnect with God more faithfully. We would always say this is a season of spiritual renewal where we examine ourselves and in humility, acknowledge our sinfulness, seek God's forgiveness and have the willingness to once again be transformed according to God's ways. The practices that we do like prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are not mere rituals for these are means by which we allow God to reshape and reform us. Fasting leads us to recall our dependence on God; prayer attunes our hearts to God and almsgiving reflects Christ's love to the needy.

Each time we come face to face with temptations, the tendency is to choose the easiest path rather than the right one and would rather think "anyway, everybody does it" than think "what would Jesus do?" Jesus' response to temptation is always rooted in Scripture. Lent reminds us of this, to always search the courage and strength from God rather than depend on our own.



May we approach this season with an open heart though burdened, tired, discouraged, and uncertain of what lies ahead. The wilderness experience is not a place of unending despair, but of living hope. We just allow God to reshape us; it is where renewal begins. Commitment to this journey to the unknown is not just out of obligation, but of deepest desire to draw closer to God, to be transformed by Christ's love, and to serve one another with renewed faith and love.

My dear St. Paul the Apostle community, may the Spirit of God lead each of us through this season of Lent. May our journey to the wilderness bear much fruit, — deepened faith, renewed love, and awakened hope. We journey together as one community knowing that the joy of Easter awaits us at the end.

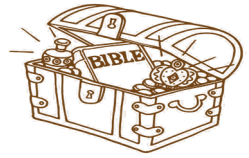

Sống trong cuộc đời, dù ở bậc sống nào đi nữa, chúng ta không thể thoát khỏi thử thách cám dỗ. Các vị thánh là những người đã can đảm đối diện và chiến thắng cám dỗ. Nếu đọc tiểu sử của các vị thánh như Thánh Antôn ẩn tu, Thánh Phanxicô Assisi, Thánh Catharina de Siena, Thánh Têrêsa Avila... chúng ta sẽ thấy các ngài là những người đã trải qua những cơn cám dỗ khốc liệt. Như vậy, ta có thể định nghĩa: các thánh là những người đã chiến thắng cám dỗ để trung thành với Chúa cho đến cùng. Lời Chúa từ sách Sáng thế cho ta thấy cám dỗ là vấn đề "xưa như trái đất". Cám dỗ đã hiện hữu ở đầu lịch sử, khi con người còn trong trắng và thân tình với Chúa Những cám dỗ đến với ta chưa hẳn phải là tội. Chúng giống như những lời quảng cáo chào mời, nếu chúng ta khôn ngoan khước từ,



thì không bị mắc bẫy. Chúa Giêsu đã chiến thắng cám dỗ. Các tác giả Tin Mừng nhất lãm đều thuật lại việc Chúa chịu cám dỗ trong hoang địa trước khi khởi đầu sứ vụ công khai. Phải chăng đó là một lời khẳng định cho chúng ta thấy, để thi hành sứ vụ làm chứng cho Chúa, chúng ta

phải được tinh luyện, thử thách như vàng thử lửa, nhờ đó chúng ta có đủ sức kiên trì và vững vàng trước những cám dỗ đang vây quanh chúng ta.

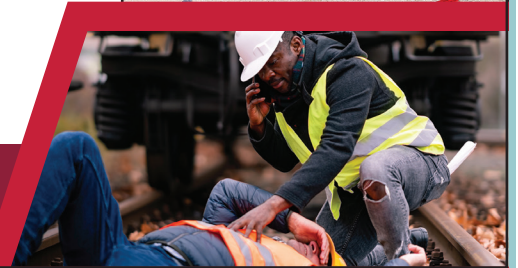


