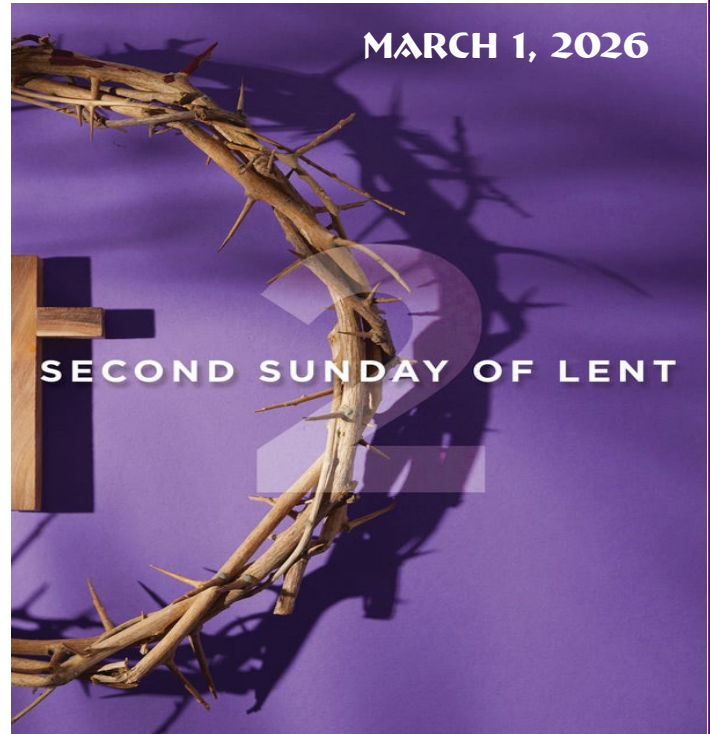
My Dear People of God:

Last Sunday, we journeyed into the wilderness where we were challenged to go about transformation, reparation, and renewal of life. This second Sunday of Lent, we are invited to ascend the mountain-top, — from wilderness experience to mountain-top experience, moving from facing temptation to transfiguration, from struggle to revelation. Lent then, invites us to go deeper and to take a moment of silence, reflect more deeply, and respond to the call of God more faithfully.

Our first reading recounts how God called Abraham, made a promise and sent him saying: "Go forth from the land of your kinsfolk and from your father's house to a land that I will show you." Abraham's response was with faith and trust. This mirrors our response to God's call, leaving everything behind, leaving what is familiar and trusting in God's promise. Lent challenges us, the way God challenged Abraham, to step out in faith, getting out from our comfort zones, leaving old habits, and fully entrusting that God is leading us to a new life.

In the Gospel, Jesus leads his disciples Peter, James and John to the mountain-top and witness his Transfiguration, — his face shines like the sun, and his clothes become dazzling white with Moses and Elijah by his side, and a voice from the cloud declares, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." At that moment, Jesus reveals his divine glory, his disciples are overwhelmed, and so Jesus reassures them: "Rise, and do not be afraid."

This season of Lent invites us to heed God's call and encourages us to always seek God's presence that leads us to moments of transformation. This is a journey not only for letting go of what is sinful but also holding on to our faith and trust in God. We are no longer afraid of what lies ahead as long as we allow God to lead us. Both Abraham and the disciples listened to God's voice and



followed, even when the path was uncertain and we are invited to do the same. Discerning what needs to change in our lives leads us to a deeper and more meaningful relationship with God in Jesus.

As we continue our Lenten journey, let us also join in prayer our brothers and sisters in the OCIA who are already baptized and preparing for the sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time, that as they look forward for their full communion with the Catholic Church, may they feel the warmth of God's loving mercy and forgiveness. May the season of Lent be a moment in which the grace of the sacrament of Reconciliation fills the hearts of these candidates, renewing their minds and hearts and be transformed according to the ways of God. And altogether, we proclaim our responsorial Psalm, "Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you."

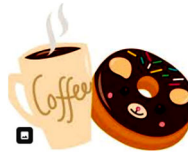

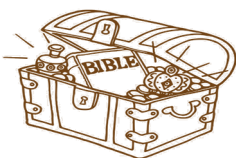

Chúa hiện diện qua Lời Chúa, qua cộng đoàn cầu nguyện, qua người nghèo khổ và nhất là trong Bí tích Thánh Thể. Chúa đang biến hình trong đời sống của chúng ta. Mùa Chay là thời điểm giúp chúng ta nhận ra Chúa Giêsu đang hiện diện, để chúng ta gặp gỡ Người. Thánh Phaolô nhắc chúng ta hãy nhận ra Đức Giêsu là Con yêu dấu của Chúa Cha. Sự kiện Chúa biến hình trên núi cũng nhắc chúng ta cần phải biến đổi đời sống, biến đổi hình ảnh của Chúa trong đời và biến đổi nhận định về tha nhân. Hãy nghe lại lời của Chúa Cha: “Đây là Con yêu dấu của Ta. Ta hài lòng về Người. Các người hãy nghe lời Người”. Lời đầu tiên Chúa Giêsu nói với các môn đệ liền tiếp sau đó là: “Chỗi dậy đi, đừng sợ!”. Hôm nay Chúa vẫn đang nói với chúng ta những điều ấy. Đừng sợ trước thân phận yếu hèn và tội lỗi, hãy trở về với Chúa vì Chúa bao dung nhân từ. Đừng sợ khi giúp đỡ anh chị em bất hạnh cô thế, cô thân, vì Chúa sẽ thưởng cho lòng quảng đại rộng rãi của chúng ta. Đừng sợ trước những bất ổn của cuộc sống do bạo lực, cạnh tranh và chia rẽ, vì Chúa hiện diện giữa cuộc đời.

Người là Đấng đang biến hình giữa chúng ta.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

La liturgia de hoy está llena de símbolos de gloria y majestad. Si estamos atentos, podremos descubrir el gran amor de Dios hacia su Hijo Jesús y también hacia nosotros, manifestado en su Transfiguración. La gloria futura se presenta en la nube como signo de la presencia de Dios, así como en los vestidos blancos y el rostro de Jesús resplandeciente como el sol. *“A la vista de ellos, su aspecto cambió completamente: su cara brillaba como el sol y su ropa se volvió blanca como la luz”* (Mateo 17:2). La muerte que Jesús había anunciado previamente a sus discípulos, la que iba a padecer, será transformada en gloria en la Pascua. Sin embargo, para llegar a esa Pascua hay que pasar por el camino del Calvario, hacia la cruz. Pedro propuso hacer tres tiendas; estaba tan bien allí, con sus compañeros y con Jesús. De repente, se escucha la voz del Padre que dice: *“Este es mi Hijo, el Amado; éste es mi Elegido, ¡escúchenlo!”* (Mateo 17:5).

Para ser verdaderos seguidores de Jesús, debemos desinstalarnos de nuestras comodidades y de nuestros caprichos. La Cuaresma, que apenas comienza, debe llevarnos a comprometernos con el bien común y con la justicia que tanto necesita la sociedad actual. La dura realidad que estamos viviendo debe ser también un camino para encontrar la



luz y la voz de Dios que nos llama a despertar y actuar frente a las necesidades de los demás. También cabe la pregunta: ¿a quién estamos escuchando? ¿A quién, o a qué, le estamos haciendo caso? Recordemos que seguir al Maestro exige esfuerzo y entrega. Bajemos, pues, de lo alto del monte para caminar con Jesús en esta Cuaresma.

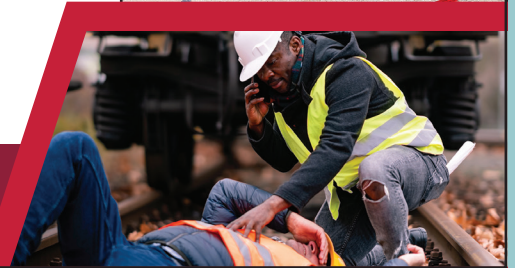


