## BAPTISM INFORMATION

Infant Baptisms are held on specific Saturdays as follows:

☐ Saturday at 9:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. or TBA

This form is for **Infant Baptisms**, which means the child to be baptized is 6 years old or younger.

Prior to scheduling a baptism date, **each parent** and **each Godparent are required** to complete a Baptismal Preparation Class separately. Classes are offered online at **lacatholics.org/baptism/**. Read and view materials, answer questions and provide your email address to receive your certificate of completion. A certificate is needed for **each Parent** and **each Godparent**.

Godparent Requirements: One Godparent is sufficient. If there are two, one must be male and the other female. Godparent/s must be at least 16 years old, have received the Sacrament of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation, and a registered active member of a parish. (Please ask each Catholic Godparent to fill out the required Sponsorship Eligibility Form).

An Eastern Orthodox may act as sponsor. A non-Catholic Christian may be a witness **along with a** Catholic sponsor.

The Baptism Registration Form must be completed by the parents only. Bring completed registration form to the Parish Office *along with the Child's County Birth Certificate, all pre-baptism class certificates and Sponsorship Eligibility Form* to schedule your date of baptism.

- Registration is on a **first come-first served process**, and may be done 3 months in advance.
- A non-refundable donation of **either** *check or cash*, in support of the mission of the Church.

REMINDER: ALL documents/requirements must be completed in order to reserve a Baptism date. Make sure to bring everything to the office to register:

- \* Completed Baptism Registration Form
- \* Child's County Birth Certificate
- \* Class Certificates for each Parent and each Godparent
- \* Sponsorship Eligibility Form for each Godparent
- \* \$50.00 check or cash only

On the day of baptism, we ask that you bring a hand towel to dry your child's head.

We will provide a baptism candle.
