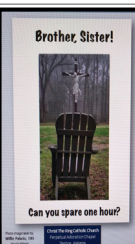


RCIA Brain Connolly will present CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING on Thursday, March 12.

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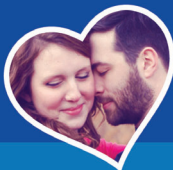
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
