Parish Wide Eucharistic Revival Volunteers Needed

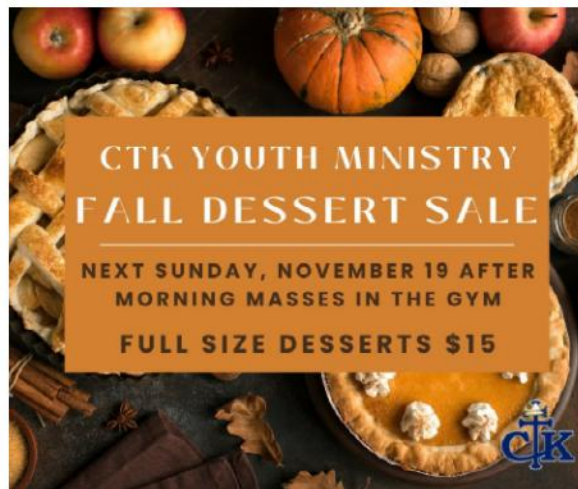
