



Coffee Social this weekend after the 7 am & 8:30 am Mass in the gym. Thanks to the Hartwell Family for hosting the social.


October is the month that Christ the King Parish helps stock the food pantry at Catholic Social Services. Please take an orange bag, fill it and return to the side doors of the church.


