



Coffee social this weekend after the 7 am & 8:30 am Mass in the gym. All are invited! Special thanks to the Disciples of the Last Table for hosting the social.


The flowers on the altar this weekend are given in memory of Vicki Guarisco from her sister Kathi Alsip.




