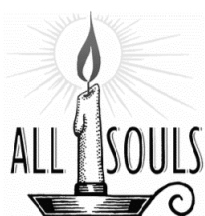

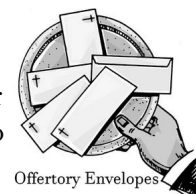
Following the talk our youth will prepare snack bags to be distributed by the HAC Van volunteers.

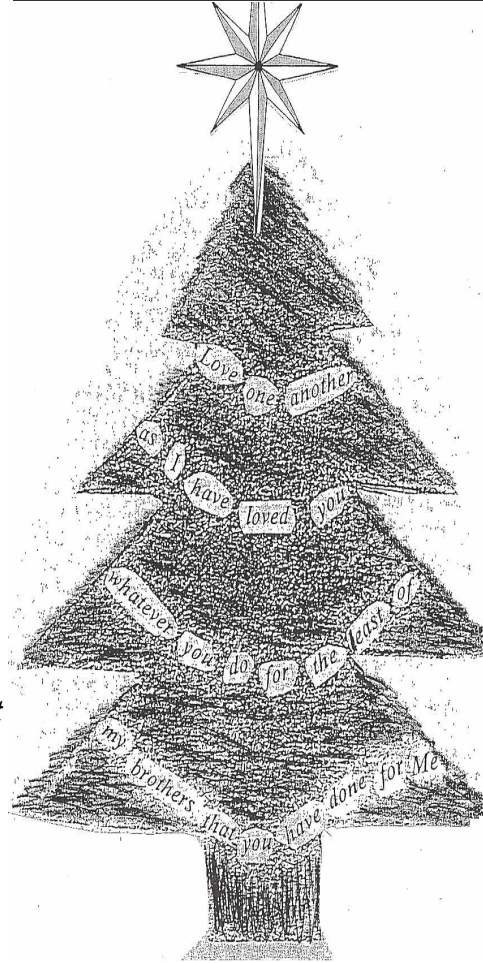
GIVING TREE

Next weekend, November 17th and 18th, begins our Annual Giving Tree!

Thank you in advance for your continued participation in this wonderful tradition.

If you wish to purchase a gift, go to one of the Christmas trees and select one of the two-piece tags with labels.

***WRITE YOUR NAME and PHONE NUMBER on the WHITE RECTANGLE and LEAVE IT in the basket by the tree.** Purchase the gift, wrap it (please include a gift receipt inside the gift before wrapping, especially for clothing) and securely attach the colored, labeled tag to the outside of the package.*



Please return the gift no later than 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, December 9th.

If you wish to donate money, take a tree-shaped tag. You may donate any amount from \$5 up to whatever amount you decide. (Please make checks payable to: St. Vincent's Giving Tree).

Please leave your donation in the basket by the tree or place it in a plain envelope marked "Giving Tree," and put it in the collection basket. You may take a tree tag home as part of our tradition.

WHERE DOES THE "TREE TAG" MONEY GO?

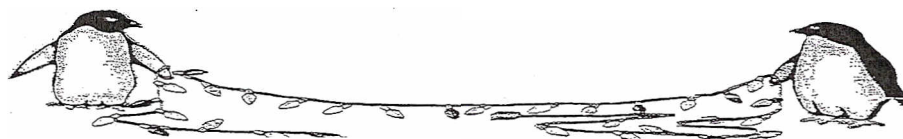
All donations made through our "tree tags" support the work of the Food Pantry. Your gifts help in the following ways: buying any missing gifts; supplying Price Chopper gift cards for families' holiday dinners; supporting the routine ministry of the Food Pantry

WHAT HAPPENS IF I LOSE THE TAG?

We can track lost tags IF YOU FILLED OUT THE WHITE RECTANGLE & LEFT IT IN THE BASKET. Please call the church as soon as you realize that it is gone and we will call you back with the necessary information.

WHAT IF I RETURN THE GIFT LATE?

Late gifts cost money & cause extra work for our Giving Tree committee. You may know that you intend to bring in the gift, but we have to assume that the gift needs to be replaced. If gifts are not in on time, the committee must use some of the 'tree tag' money to buy missing gifts.

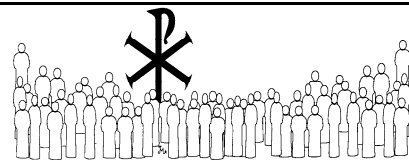

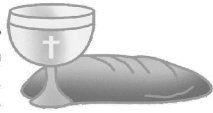
