Pilgrimage to Israel: March 12-20, 2022

As the vaccine is slowly becoming available, one is invited to think to the future and what might be possible. To this end Elizabeth is organizing a pilgrimage to Israel for 2022. The itinerary includes Tel Aviv, Nazareth, Capernaum, Jerusalem, including the Vad Yasheem Holocaust Memorial and the Via Dololorosa. Optional excursions include Bethlehem and the Dead Sea. A tour extension to Jordan is also possible. Basic price, including airfare, before optional excursions, single supplement (if desired) and travel insurance is \$3,719. The deposit is \$99 for those who enroll through auto pay. If one enrolls by the end of February one may cancel by May 1, 2021 without penalty. Becoming a Catholic Christian


Perhaps you have been sitting in the community, worshipping with us but are not a Catholic and have been wondering how to become one.

CHANGES TO THE BISHOP'S APPEAL

We want to let you know about a few changes to the annual campaign formerly known as the Bishop's Appeal:

- The campaign will now be known as the *Diocesan* Appeal and themed, "For we walk by faith, not by sight." (2 Corinthians 5:7)
- There will no longer be "in-pew" collection of pledges.
- The 2020-2021 Diocesan Appeal will begin with a mailing sent to parishioners from the Roman Catholic Diocese of Albany (RCDA) - Office of Stewardship and Development. You should expect to receive this correspondence between now and early September; it will include a pledge card and envelope.
- Pledges and payments will no longer be processed in the parish office.
- The appeal year runs through June 30, 2021 (rather than ending in March as in the past).


