

### Food Pantry Stats: November 2022

The Food Pantry served 485 households in November, including 1178 adults, 672 children, 192 infants/toddlers and 93 seniors totaling 2,135 individuals fed. Our Rides Home Volunteers provided grocery drop off to 225 Households. We also provided 2-ride bus passes to 68 guests. Funding from the Food Pantries for the Capital District provided funding for \$20 gift cards for Thanksgiving. 194 households with children received the cards. Thank you for your ongoing support of the Food Pantry and our hungry neighbors.


