



A LITTLE FAITH

Today our readings are about faith, frustration, and how much is enough. Habakkuk is a complainer having an argument with God. Timothy is encouraging a community challenged by cowardice and the apostles want more faith than they have. Things aren't happening fast enough for any of them or for us. All of them and we want God to do something sooner rather than later and we want God to give us a reason to believe that it will all work out. What does God do? God puts it back on them—and us—telling Habakkuk to describe the world he wants; telling the apostles to do more than the expected. Doing more with less is a familiar phrase today and a reminder that a little faith may be enough even for the most difficult times.





We will have a Sacristan Workshop in the Church for anyone interested in learning what is involved in being a Sacristan or current Sacristans who would like a refresher.

Working as a Sacristan is the foundational job of the Altar Society.

And the one that we need help with the most!

It is a ministry that really brings us closer to God and his church.
Sacristans work as a team for one month a year to set up for weekend Masses, clean the linens and vessels, fill holy water fonts, replace candles and any other tasks to ensure that the church and Altar are ready for Mass and other services.

The Altar Society is the oldest organization for women at our church. We meet in the Parish Hall on the first Thursday of the month from September to June. Meetings start at 10am, usually last about an hour and are followed by a pot luck lunch.

Attendance at meetings is not required

In addition to meetings and Sacristan teams, there are various committees with specific jobs, such as Bereavement, Candles, Courtesy, Decorations, Funerals, History/Publicity, Membership, Social, Telephone and Weddings.

We also have a Bake Sale fund raiser every Palm Sunday Weekend. We host the Confirmation Reception for our newly Confirmed and a March birthday party for Lane Nursing Home residents.
