CHANGE

Lent is all about change and change is usually not easy. In order to change we have to leave something behind. Today we hear about a very old man who decides to answer God's call. Abram experiences a tremendous amount of change when he leaves everything behind, risking it all for God's promise. Jesus changes, is transfigured, right before the eyes of his disciples. The Lenten scriptures issue the call for us to change, to be transfigured, so that we, too, will soon share in the glory of God. What is it that the Lord is asking us to leave behind? Are we willing to take the risk for the promise made by God? These questions are at the heart of the Lenten journey of conversion.

Turning Points

Our readings today describe turning points for those whom God has chosen. In Genesis, God calls Abram to leave his homeland, with the promise of forming a people in a new land. In the Gospel, the disciples see Jesus literally in a new light, the bright light of Jesus' transfiguration. They begin to see Jesus, and themselves, in a new way. These are times when God presents a new way forward, providing new purpose and energy. Our lives too have their own turning points, where God is working (usually in less spectacular fashion) to lead us into fuller maturity, and into deeper unity with God and others. The road ahead, as with Abram, Jesus, and the disciples, may be long and difficult. 





SUGGESTED POINTS to make with your Liturgical congregation:

- The risk for the coronavirus in Louisiana appears to be very low.
- In an abundance of caution and with the approval of our Bishop Michael Duca, some temporary changes have been suggested to be made within our liturgical practice during this time of heightened concern about public health.
- Please follow these precautions which are the same common-sense hygiene precaution recommended to prevent the flu including:
 - Avoid contact with sick persons
 - Cover mouth/ nose with tissue/sleeve when coughing/ sneezing.
 - Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth after touching objects.
 - Practice good health habits at home.
- Regarding the celebration of Mass, please pay attention to the following:
 - If you are sick, DO NOT come to Mass. One does not sin if a person is ill and absent from the Eucharist. Come back to the celebration of the Eucharist after you recover.
 - We are temporarily withholding the Communion Chalice at daily and weekend Eucharistic liturgies. The Chalice will be restored once the threat of the communicable disease has passed.
 - You are temporarily encouraged to receive Holy Communion on the hand and not the tongue during this time.
 - Refrain from holding hands [unless you are family] during the Lord's Prayer and
 offer the ritual Sign of Peace with a simple bow or wave. Some may be
 uncomfortable with physical contact during some parts of Mass at this time.
 - All the liturgical ministers will wash their hands with soap and water before
 Mass begins and after Mass ends. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion
 will also use an alcohol based anti-bacterial solution before and after
 distributing Holy Communion.
- These are being asked of us all for the good order of our worship during this special time. Coming to Mass is never risk free as we are humans and live in a world that can be precarious. However, we can join in prayer for the many in the world who are suffering from all manner of diseases, for those who care for them and for the welfare and healing of all the sick. We can pray for the safety of our family, our friends and parishioners.
- I will keep you informed when these guides can be changed.
