Rules and Regulations

- The Knights of Columbus Essay Contest is open to all Catholic Students from public, private, parochial schools, or home school in **grades 8-12**.
- Each essay must reflect the assigned theme and be the student's original work.
- Each Essay must be typed and contain between 500-750 words.
- All Council submissions must have the Supreme Essay Participation Form 4208 attached and include the signature of the student and parent.
- One winning essay from each grade level will advance to the next level of competition.
- The <u>student's name should only appear on the official entry form and not in the essay.</u>

Deadlines

- September 1, 2023- Deadline to Order Essay Kits from the Supreme Council
- November 15, 2023- Deadline for Students to submit essays to their Councils
- December 5, 2023- Deadline for Councils to submit its winning essays to the Diocesan Administrators
- January 2, 2024- Deadline for Diocesan Administrators to State Community Director

Judging

Essay will be judged on a 100-point scoring system.

- 35 Points Content- How clearly is the theme presented?
- 30 Points Grammar- Does the essay reflect proper sentence and paragraph and utilize correct spelling?
- 35 Points Style- Does the essay show creativity, imagination, and development of the topic in a compelling style?

Awards

- Council 10080 award winner in each grade level will recieve a \$75.00 check.
- Diocesan winners in each grade level will receive a \$50.00 check.
- State winners in each grade level will receive a \$200.00 check.
- State winners will advance to the Knights of Columbus International Essay Contest.
- International winners in each grade level will receive \$300 and a framed certificate
- The Supreme Council will honor two essay runners-up in each grade level and each runner-up will receive \$100 and a framed certificate.

All entries become the property of the Knights of Columbus and will not be returned.

RULES

JUDGING

Judges (three or more) will be selected by the sponsoring Knights of Columbus council, assembly or circle. Council and/or assembly members, teachers, clergy, civil officials and/or members of the community may serve as judges.

A **100-point scoring system** will be used to determine the winner.

35 Points: Content — How thoroughly is the topic examined?

30 Points: Grammar — How well is the essay written with respect to sentence and paragraph construction?

35 Points: Style — Does the essay show creativity, imagination and development of the topic in a logical and compelling style?
