SCRIP fundraising, also known as gift card fundraising, has been the #1 fundraiser for nonprofit organizations across the U.S. for more than 25 years. It's easy and convenient. Saint Anne's Altar Society has been using this fundraiser for 15+ years. We are currently hoping to rejuvenate this program by increasing participation. By simply buying gift cards to use for everyday purchases, in addition to buying them to use as gifts when the need arises, you can earn money for St. Anne's. The earnings come directly from the brands you shop, not from your pocket, so your gift cards are worth full value. There are 750+ brands to choose from in the SCRIP program. You can choose from eGift cards and physical gift cards. Reloading cards is also available on a limited number of brands. You can use your physical gift cards in-store or online or access your eGift cards right from your online account. There is no expiration date on SCRIP cards. There is no limit to the earning potential of this program.

There is a list posted on each bulletin board of the gift cards that are available from SCRIP. The list also shows the card types available and the rebate percentage that will go to St. Anne's when you purchase a specific card. These percentages vary from brand to brand. If you would like to have a copy of this list to take home, see Linda Etchison or Karen Whitehead. You can also find this information as well as current specials and availability at https://www.RaiseRight.com.

How do I purchase SCRIP cards? Currently there are three ways to purchase SCRIP gift cards.

- 1) We will have a variety of SCRIP cards on hand which can be purchased after weekend Masses or by contacting Linda or Karen. If anyone has requests for brands to keep on hand, please let Linda or Karen know and we will be sure to keep in stock the brands most often used.
- 2) Orders will be placed on Mondays. If you have need of a certain gift card, place your order with Linda (618 214 6768) or Karen (618 572 8206). The orders are placed on Monday and should be in later the same week. They can be picked up the following weekend or as soon as they come in – whatever works best for you.
- 3) You can also order your own cards by becoming a participant. Setting up your personal account is a simple process. If you are interested in this method, text or email Karen Whitehead (618 572 8206) (twkw89@msn.com) to get information on this process and the link which will include the code needed to be able to set up your personal account and earn money for St. Anne's. When you become a participant and order your own cards, you will also pay a small shipping fee if you order the physical card rather than an eCard. Many cards are able to be shipped directly to your home. Some cards are only eligible to be shipped to the coordinator, but you can still order them from your personal account. In addition, there is a small fee depending on the type of payment you choose. If you choose to pay with a credit card, there is a 2.6% fee per transaction. If you choose to pay directly from your bank account, there is only a \$.29 fee per transaction.


