

Bishop Michael McGovern invites you to the Annual Diocesan Spring Blessing of the Farm on Wednesday, April 26, 2023, at 1:00 PM at the Farm of Paul and Jan Blankenberger. The Farm is located at the Corner of US-Hwy 45 & County Hwy 1850 N in Enfield, Illinois 62835.

You can arrive at their farm by taking US-Hwy 45 South from Interstate-64 at mile marker-exit 110. Travel 9 miles south on US-Hwy 45 to County Hwy, 1850 N. Farm will be on your left.

OR Travel 3 miles North of Enfield, IL on US-Hwy 45 to County Hwy 1850 N. Farm will be on your right. "Farm Blessing" signs will also lead you to the farm. Those attending are invited to bring seed and soil in marked containers along with animals and farm machinery to be blessed. Food will also be collected for the needy of the area.
