The life of our dear Lord in the Sacred Host is most active. He remains still in the tabernacle, it is true, but graces are flying forth from His Heart in inconceivable abundance. From the tabernacle, Our Lord works miracles both in souls and bodies, as He did of old in Galilee and Judea.

The Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. They believe that God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and sent out in mission "for the life of the world." The third year of the revival – the year of parish renewal – began on June 11, 2023. The goal of the revival is "renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist." These three years will culminate in the first National Eucharistic Congress in the United States in almost fifty years. Almost a hundred thousand Catholics will join together in Indianapolis in 2024 for a once-in-a-lifetime pilgrimage toward the "source and summit" of our Catholic faith.


