The third year of the revival – the year of parish renewal – began on June 11, 2023. The goal of the revival is "renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist." These three years will culminate in the first National Eucharistic Congress in the United States in almost fifty years. Almost a hundred thousand Catholics will join together in Indianapolis in 2024 for a once-in-a-lifetime pilgrimage toward the "source and summit" of our Catholic faith.


St. Anne's Altar Society will have a meeting on Sunday, September 3 after mass.
