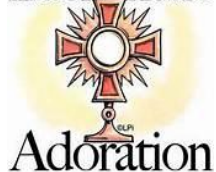

We are looking for volunteers to staff the Coffee Shop on Sunday mornings after the 9:00am Mass. Please contact the rectory at #508-987-8892



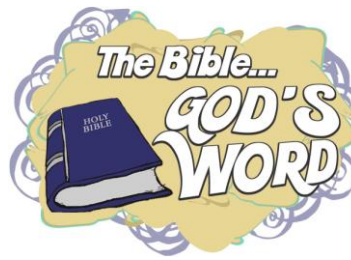
We welcome **Samantha Wagner** who was baptized on Sunday, September 11<sup>th</sup>. May God bless her and her family.
