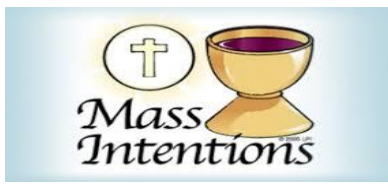
Confessions will be held in the church confessional on Saturdays from 3:00 to 3:45 pm or by appointment.
