Time's Running out to Register!

Religious Education Program: 2023 - 2024

Registration for this year's religious education program is open for all children from Kindergarten through 8th grade. Basic details are below. For more information, please email Kay Kiernan at kaykiernan95@yahoo.com.

Who can register? Our program is open to all children who do not attend Catholic school and whose families are registered with St. Thomas More.

What ages are included? We welcome students from Kindergarten through 8th Grade.

What is the cost of the program? The registration fee is \$40/student, with a maximum of \$100/family.

When are the Sacraments received? The Diocese of Paterson permits students to receive their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion after they have completed 2 years of religious education, so this typically occurs in 2nd Grade. Similarly, the Diocese requires each student to complete 2 years of preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, which typically occurs at St. Thomas More in 8th grade or later.

Diocese of Paterson Marian Pilgrimage to National Shrine in Washington, D.C.

The Diocesan Marian Pilgrimage to the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. is returning this year for the first time since 2017. This trip will provide a unique opportunity to join others from throughout the Diocese in a powerful spiritual experience with Bishop Sweeney on his first diocesan pilgrimage as bishop.

Participants have two options, either a one-day pilgrimage on Saturday, October 14, or an overnight, two-day pilgrimage from Friday, October 13 through Saturday, October 14. On the one-day pilgrimage, all pilgrims will visit the Byzantine and Romanesque basilica, attend Mass with Bishop Sweeney, have an opportunity for confessions in Crypt Church, be invited to participate in a multi-lingual recitation of the Rosary and the Divine Mercy Chaplet, experience Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and enjoy quiet devotional time in the basilica, which has more than 80 chapels and oratories. The cost for the one-day trip is \$65 per person and includes transportation, gratuity and activities at the shrine. The departure points will be announced at a later date, but it is anticipated that buses will leave our Diocese between 6 - 6:45 am and leave Washington, D.C. at 4:15 pm.

For the overnight tour, in addition to the above, the pilgrims will visit the Franciscan Monastery of the Holy Land in America, which has a Byzantine-style church and replicas of Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto and shrines from the Holy Land, including Mount Calvary, and also a cloister walk and beautiful gardens. The cost of the overnight option is \$280 double occupancy/\$335 single occupancy, and includes bus transportation, the visit to the Franciscan Monastery of the Holy Land, a banquet dinner with Bishop Sweeney on Friday evening, a Saturday morning breakfast buffet, accommodations at The Westin Tysons Corner Hotel in Falls Church, Virginia, and all taxes and gratuities.
